

Remarks On Board Bark Northern Lights Op
Thursday June 25th 1868

Commenced with strong breeze and
hazy sun S.E. Ends with strong breezes
and fine weather at daylight. Saw the
Island of Neutulla Bay at 8 A.M.

Friday June 26th
Commenced with strong
breezes and fine weather. Ends with
fresh S.E. Trades and fine weather
bracing off the west End of the
Island Neutulla.

Saturday June 27th
Commenced with fresh
Trades and fine weather. Ends the
same had some Boats off to Trade.

Sunday June 28th
Strong Trades and squally
with lightning. Ends with strong
Trades and fine weather off and on.

Monday June 29th
Strong Trades and fine
fine weather. Middle and latter
light Trades well to the East.

Tuesday June 30th
Light breeze with rain
squalls from S.E. off and on the
land. Ends with light breeze from S.E.
Sent in three 21 Casks for Water.

Wednesday July 1st
Light breeze and squally.
Mr Havens on shore to fill the Water
at daylight. Boat went in to Trade
and send the Water off. Ends baffling.

New Bedford Capt. Michael Baker Master
Thursday July 2nd 1868

Commenced baffling got off
18 Casks of Water had to put them
3 to save going or there had a reason
Chance heavy squalls right in there
and heavy rain all 4 Boats towing
ship around and heading her off. There
got off all clear at dark. Ends
with squally and rainy from all parts.

Friday July 3rd
Commenced with squally with
heavy rain. Ends raining and squally.

Saturday July 4th
Commenced with rainy and
squally weather from all parts of the
Compass. Ends the same.

Sunday July 5th
Commenced with strong breeze
with squally rainy weather from all
parts of the Compass at 11 put up a
citt. Sent Mr Silvey in to carry
7 natives and get a load of coconuts.
Ends with strong breeze and squally at
9 am. Mr Silvey came off brought off
a load of coconuts.

Monday July 6th
Commenced with strong Trades and
hazy breezing. Sent strong to hold up
Saw Blackfish. Ends with strong Trades
and squally 2 Boats in Trade.

Tuesday July 7th
Commenced strong Trades at 3 pm.
The Boat came off with 3 coconuts left
off to the Southward. Ends with strong
Trades and hazy. Dec 15-1868
