

Remarks On Board Bark Northern Light Of
Wednesday July 8th 1868

Commenced with strong trade
and fine weather heady 6th P.M.
Ends with strong trade and fine weather
both Bob stays fasten

Thursday July 9th
Commenced with strong trade
and fine weather Ends with strong
trades from the Eastward with rain clearing
off at short sail

Friday July 10th
Commenced with strong easterly
wind with frequent rain squalls
middle the same Ends strong breezes from
E.S.E. of the wind to the S.E.

Saturday July 11th
Commenced with strong breezes
from E.S.E. by the wind to the S.E. Ends
with fresh breezes and fine weather from
E.S.E. at daylight. Saw the Island of
Neopole bearing to the S.W.

Sunday July 12th
Commenced with fresh trade
and fine weather. Saw Hump backs
thought them to be sperm whale towards
4 boats Ends fine working up for
Neopole

Monday July 13th
Commenced with fine weather
at 4 P.M. came to anchor in Neopole
in 7 fathoms. Weather Ends with fine weather
fixing the Bob stays and Buss got clear
of both of the Emma & Jones gave some
iron from shore all hands busy

New Bedford Capt Michel Baker Master
Tuesday July 14th 1868

Commenced with fine weather
Employed on the Head Sear setting up
Shocks for water. Ends the same got
on 2 Bob stays sent out the fifth beam
and set of the Head Sear

Wednesday July 15th
Commenced with fine weather
Employed setting up and Seasing off
Head Rigging. Ends the same

Thursday July 16th
Fine weather all these 24 hours
Employed setting up the Rigging got
on the other Bob stay getting water

Friday July 17th
Employed getting off water
with vapor got on getting
by getting herby. Ends strong water getting ready
for sea. Put the men on there
what broke his leg discharged
him in the Councils hands

Saturday July 18th
All the 24 hours fresh trade
and fine weather at 11 am took
the Anchor and stood out to sea

Sunday July 19th
Commenced with strong trade
Ends with fresh trade and fine weather

Monday July 20th
Commenced with strong trade with
the S off and on. Sailed with the Emma
& Jones Ends with light trade and fine
weather working up to weather the same
