Tuesday July 21st 1868

Commenced with light trades
and fine weather working up to weather
the Island Enos with light breezes from
the Eastward working up to weather the
Island

Wednesday July 22nd

Commenced with light breeze
from S.E. Employed cleaning and painting
iron work Enos with light breezes and
thick hazy from S.E.

Thursday July 23rd

Commenced with strong breeze
and raining from E.S.E. by the land
to the S. Made fine weather Enos with
a fresh Gale and rain storm from E.S.E.
heaving South West Sail

Friday July 24th

Commenced with a fresh
Gale and a rain storm from E.S.E.
Enos with a fresh Gale and squally
from S.E.

Saturday July 25th

Commenced with a fresh Gale
from S.E. Enos with strong breezes
and fine weather from E.S.E. Course
West

Commenced with strong
breezes and fine weather from E.S.E.

the E at 8 am saw Flagon of Chaghe

Commenced with thick squally
from E Course W by S Enos with thick
hazy weather from E.S.E. Course S by W
