Thursday Dec 10th 1868
Commenced with fine weather
from the Northward Employed Boiling
and Seasing off the main Rigging
Ends Squatted from N.W. and W.

Friday Dec 11th
Commenced with Squally
from W. & S. with light Showers
off main Ends fine weather from the
S. Stearing off N.W. & N. and S.E.

Lat 31.49 S
Long on Meridian

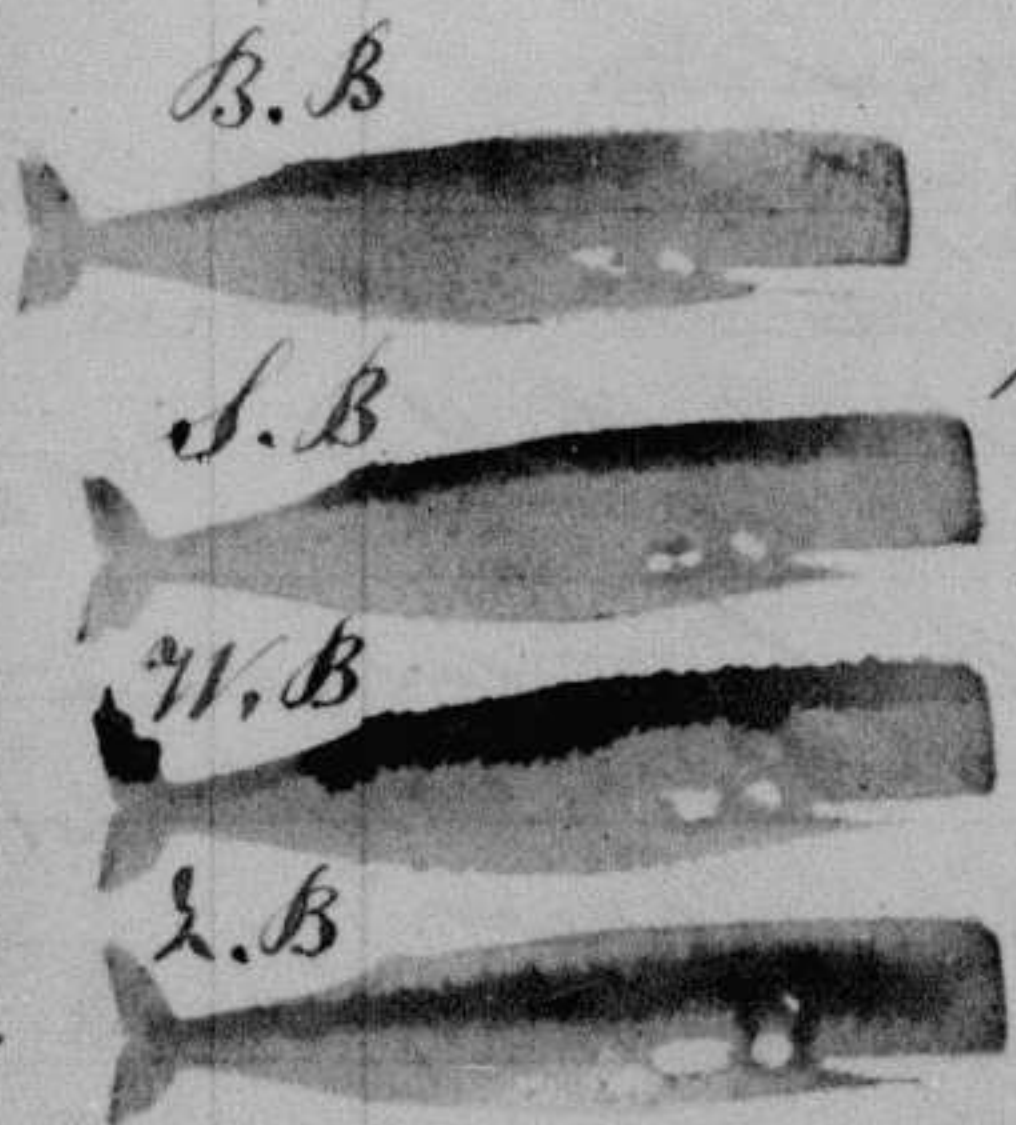
Saturday Dec 12th
Commenced with fine weather
from the South Stearing off different
Courses from S.E. to N.W. Employed
on the Rigging Ends fine from the
South Course N.E. & S.

Lat 31.01 S
Long 179.41 W

Sunday Dec 13th
Commenced with fresh breeze and
fine weather from S. Course N.E. & S.
at 1 p.m. saw Whales lower
4 boats to it & got then by the
ship at sunset Ends fine
weather finished cutting the
Whales at 11.30 am

Monday Dec 14th
Commenced with fine weather
from S.E. Employed clearing away
the Heads started the Works at 6
p.m. Ends with fine weather from
E. and veering to the N.E.

Commenced with fine weather
from S.E. Employed Boiling Saw
Something called them Sperm Whales
lowered 3 Boats Chased them till Sun
Set going quick Spoke the mile
board Home Ends with light breeze
and hardy at 11.30 am saw a shoal
of Sperm Whales lowered 3 Boats

L.B. Mist 2
W.B. Mist 2
Mist 4 times

Wednesday Dec 16th
Commenced with light breeze
and calm Chasing the Whales L.B.
Mist 2 W.B. Mist 2 Saw the mile
board Ends fine weather from
the Westward finished Boiling at
7 am. Cleared up and commenced
coopering mile in light

Thursday Dec 17th
Commenced with fine weather
from the Southward Employed Coopering
separately to show down Ends with
light and variable winds Employed
stowing down Lat 30.15 S

Friday Dec 18th
Commenced with light and
variable winds finished stowing oil
and got some shovels ready to set up
Ends fine weather washing ship
Lat

Saturday Dec 19th
Commenced with fine weather
from the Eastward Stearing off N.W.
and S.W. Ends with fine weather from
E. & S.E. of the ground opposite Facke
saw Boat Island Lat 30.45 S
Long 178.58 W
