Ship getting ready to Paint Ship Encls
with cloudy weather Employed clearing
up Blacking Bends & watch in Liberty
Painting inside

Sunday Mch 21st

Commenced with fine weather
Ends fine weather Watch in Liberty

Monday Mch 22nd

Commenced with fine weather
Ends with fine weather Employed Painting
Ship Out Side 2 Boats Crews Off with
Capt Baker

Tuesday Mch 23rd

Commenced with fine weather
Employed Painting Ship Ends with fine
weather watch in Liberty

Wednesday Mch 24th

All three 24 hour fine weather
Employed Painting in different parts
of the Ship Watch in Liberty

Thursday Mch 25th

Fine weather took 11 and 24
Cords of Wood Sawing and Stowing it
away Ends with fine weather Employed
Stowing Wood took 26 Sines of Bark
Watch in Liberty

Friday Mch 26th

Commenced fine weather took
40 Sacks of Flour Employed Stowing Flour
and clearing up got off a raft of Wood

Saturday Mch 27th 1869

Commenced with fine weather took
24 Sines Potatoes 10 Hogs Painted Bends
Ends with rainy weather

Sunday Mch 28th

Commenced with rainy weather
Ends fine weather watch in Liberty

Monday Mch 29th

Commenced with fine weather
Ends with fine weather Employed getting off
and Stowing away Potatoes halted Oct

Tuesday Mch 30th

Commenced with fine weather
Set up the Main Rigging Ends fine

Wednesday Mch 31st

All three fine weather got 2 Barks
of Walter Employed getting ready for sea

Thursday April 1st 1869

Commenced with fine weather
through out the day

Friday April 2nd

Commenced with fine weather
Ends the same Employed at various
Jobs

Saturday April 3rd

Fine weather Employed at various
Jobs fitting 2 new Boats Ends with
wet heavy weather

Sunday April 4th

Commenced with thick weather
Ends with fine weather
