Tuesday April 13th 1869

then they got him up put him in
double buns, at midnight the St George
put in sight off dock at 130 pm
bearsd ship toward the St George

Commenced moderate
buses and haze from E. S. E. at
3.30 pm got down to the St George went
on board at dark Capt Baker Mr
Remington and myself came on
board all being quiet and the
mutineers being secure only with
light-uses and haze from the

Commenced with thick
and haze from N. E. and S. W.
at 5 pm run down to the St George
Capt Baker went on board and
found Capt Sewel had the mutineers
all sighted only with fresh breezes
from the Westward 3 sail in sight

Commenced with thick
foggy weather from W. S. W. 4 sail in
sight only with fresh breezes and thick
hazy weather from S. W. course off

Saturday April 17th

Commenced with fresh breezes
from S. W. course off E. S. E. and with
fine weather from S. W. 2 sail in
sight

Commenced with fresh breezes
and fine weather from S. W. 2 sail in
sight different courses 2 sail in sight
only with fine weather course off

from S. W. and W. S. W. at 4 pm luffed
to the S. E. nothing in sight only
fine winds light from E. S. E.

Commenced with light

E. S. E. watches employed at various
jobs cold taring anchors etc
only fine weather from E. S. E. nothing
in sight

Lat 32.27 S

Thursday April 21st

Commenced with fine weather
from E. S. E. heaving S. W. all sail
only with fresh breezes and fine weather from
the Eastward at 9 am saw 3 sail making
run for them at 10 hours 2 boats

Lat 33.27 S

Long 179.26 E

Friday April 22nd

Fine weather 3 boats chasing
whale going quick chase till dark
only with strong breeze from E
saw 2 ship whaling stood for
them
