

Remarks On Board Bark Northern Light Of New
Monday July 5th 1869

Commenced with thick and
squally from N.E. Landing from Satawilla
W.B. ends with thick squally with heavy
rain. Saw from shore however
4 Boats took 2 nearly calm
a way between Utopia and
Satawilla

Tuesday July 6th

Commenced calm getting the
Whale to the ship took the last eye
at 5 p.m. and a butt one the other
lay till morning. Ends with fine
weather. But the whale and started
the work on the head had a canoe
come off from Satawilla

Wednesday July 7th

Commenced with squally
with heavy rain at 6 a.m. had
to cool down at 7 a fresh Sale
middle a fresh Sale from the southward
Ends moderate. Worked the Works at
daylight ran around to the N
of Satawilla

Thursday July 8th

Commenced with fresh breeze
and fine weather from S. West.
back boiling. worked down at 8 p.m.
middle squally. Ends fine weather
and fresh breeze from S.E. off and on
baking

Friday July 9th

Commenced with fresh breeze off
and on. Gradually ends with thick and
heavy from S.E. heavy off for Utopia

Bedford Capt Michael Baker Master
Saturday July 10th 1869

Commenced with thick and
raining from S.E. at 4 p.m. bent back
Charles Utopia. heavy S.E. dist-
12 or 15 miles. Middle a heavy rain
Storm ends calm

Sunday July 11th

Commenced with calm. thick
foggy from S.E. S.W. Middle moderate
breeze from the Eastward. Stood in
for the Land got the Anchors off got
ready to go in at 10 a.m. started
the Anchors in Utopia. The Hesperus
U.S. Man of War in Harbor and
3 Merchant Men. Sailed for Barge

Monday July 12th

Commenced with fine weather
from S.E. Ends with fine weather
Employed Stowing Oil in the Fore
Hatch and filling 35 casks of Water

Tuesday July 13th

Commenced with fine
weather. Ends with fine weather 2
Boats gone around the Island after
Bams

Wednesday July 14th

Spent weather all hands out
Lifting up the Rigging for and aft

Thursday July 15th

Fine weather. Employed
Lifting up Rigging. Filling Water
