Tuesday Aug 8th 1869

Commenced with thick and
raining from the Southward & the
wind to the Eastward. Saw Finbacks
Ends with fine weather from S.W.

Lat 23 20 S
Long 171 13 W

Wednesday Aug 9th

Commenced with fine
weather from S.W. Nothing in
sight. Ends Calm Employed
cleaning the Chutes and on the
Rigging

Thursday Aug 10th

Commenced Calm clearing
the Chutes and painting them
Middle light and from the Southward
Ends with fresh breeze from S.W.
by the River S.W.

Friday Aug 11th

Commenced with fresh
breeze and fair weather from S.W.
Ends with fine weather from
S.W. Employed in the Rigging Capt
Baker, Making Mat Stripes
for the Boats. Lat 25 00 S

Saturday Aug 12th

Commenced with strong
breeze from S.W. at 4 p.m. light
ages saw a number of Finbacks
Ends with light ages and Calms
Employed cleaning and painting
Chute plates Making Boat Stripes
with various jobs

Friday Aug 13th 1869

Commenced with light ages
and Calms Saw a number of Fin
backs Ends with baffling winds
and a rain storm

Saturday Aug 14th

Commenced with light
ages and rainy weather S.W. Course
S.W. and W.S. at 4 p.m. Heavy
breeze and raining from the Northward
have to close reefed. Mid. Set
Sail Ends with light baffling winds
and thick hazy weather with Hogg
Squalls

Sunday Aug 15th

Commenced with a fresh
breeze from S.W. with Hogg Squalls
Course W.S. Saw Finbacks Ends
with a fresh Gale from S.W.

Lat 25 15 S
Long 173 39 W

Monday Aug 16th

Commenced with a fresh
Gale from S.W. that sail to S.W.
Ends with strong breeze and heavy
Set

Lat 25 15 S
Long 173 39 W

Tuesday Aug 17th

Commenced with strong breeze
from S.W. Employed breaking out
by provisions and clothing. Ends with
bad Squalls from S.W. that sail
Employed fitting Blocks
