Tuesday Sept 7th 1869

Commences with fine weather
from S heading N.W. by the wind all
Sail Saw Hump & Finbacks
Ends Calms the Napoleon in Sight

Wednesday Sept 8th

Commences Calms breaking
out for time & day to repair the
try works Ends with fine weather
from S with pleasant breeze heading
to the Westward all Sail Employed
repairing the try works once to work
on the Rigging

Thursday Sept 9th

Commences with fresh breeze
and fine weather from S.E. by the
wind to the S.W. the Napoleon in
Sight. Ends with fine weather from
S.E. Set 25.09 S

Friday Sept 10th

Commences with fine
weather from E at 4 pm thick and
raining Middle the same Ends fine
weather from the Eastward, running
off West Saw Humpbacks Napoleon
in Company

Saturday Sept 11th

Commences with fresh
breezes and fine weather from East
Heaving off W. watching Employed
at various jobs rattens S.p. mast
Rigging Scrubbing beams and scrubbing
generally Middle and latter thick and
Rigging with baffling winds from all
parts

Commences with a rain
Storm veering from E to S and
N.W. veered Ship a Run by of
lines Ends with fresh breeze and
thick hazy weather from N.W. and
W.N.W. Set 25.31 S
Seng 175.06 W

Monday Sept 13th

Commences with fresh breeze
from N.W. to the S.W. Middle wind
veering to S.W. fresh breeze and squally

Tuesday Sept 14th

Commences with fresh breeze
and fine weather from S.W. watches
Employed at various jobs Napoleon
in Company Ends with fresh breeze
and haze from S

Wednesday Sept 15th

Commences with strong
breeze and rain from S.E. Sailed
with the Napoleon Ends with fine
weather from S.E. Heaving off S.W. all
Sail Employed rather S.p. mast Rigging
making stripes

Thursday Sept 16th

Commences with fine weather
from S.E. Board S.p. company
with Napoleon Saw Finbacks
Ends fine weather from E.S.E. Coasts
S.W. Employed Rattening down S.p. mast
Rigging Making truckjam with various
jobs Set 26.43 S
Seng 178.43 W
