Wednesday Oct 27th 1869
Commenced calm and foggy
at 2 p.m. cleared up with light
breezing airs Ends with light
airs from N Course S.E. all
Sail Employed at various jobs
Oct 27/40 J

Thursday Oct 28th
Commenced with a light
breeze from N Course S.E.
Ends with light breeze from N.E.
Course S.E. all sail at 8 am
Saw a Norfolk Island banyan
I kept for it

Friday Oct 29th
Light airs and fine weather
from N at 4 p.m. Coff and
Mrs Baker went on shore off
and on the Bark Petrell in
company Ends with fine weather
got off 17 Casks of Water and
Stow it

Saturday Oct 30th
Fine weather got off 17
Casks of Water and Stow it
Ends with fine weather Watch on duty

Sunday Oct 31st
Fine weather one watch came off
and the other was on liberty for
24 hours liberty

Monday Nov 1st
Fine weather from S.E. Ends with
strong breeze and fine weather from
S.E. took off the Water to rig up to
take off recruits of anchor

Beetfern Capt Michael Baker Master
Tuesday Nov 2nd 1869
Commenced with a fresh Gale
from S.E. to rig up to Land Ends
with strong Breezes from E and
S.E. 2 Boats on shore after recruits

Wednesday Nov 3rd
Strong Breezes from E took
off 2 Boat Loads of Potatoes and
Cabbages from Poles in Ends the
Saw strong breeze from S.E. off
and on the Wharfedale Barks and
Corat in company

Thursday Nov 4th
Strong Breezes 2 Boats on
shore took off 2 Bullocks one
Dead and one alive some Potatoes
Onions and Cabbages Ends with
a fresh Gale from E and S.E.
At Meridian Capt and Mrs
Baker came off stood to the
in company with the Wharfedale

Friday Nov 5th
Commenced with strong breeze
from S.E. ready to the S.E. of
Sail Ends with fresh breeze and
fine weather from S.E. Steady off
to the N of the Island dist 10 miles

Saturday Nov 6th
Commenced with fine weather
from S.E. Ends with light airs
and calm Employed painting
the 2 Boats with various jobs
of Ships duties
