thick haze from the Southward the
watches employed at various jobs
Cones with fine weather from the
Southward heading to the Westward

Wednesday Aug 3rd

Commenced with light breezes
from the South heading N.W.
Cones with light Breezes with
frequent squalls from N.W.
heading S.W. by S all sail

Commenced with light and boiling
air, and light rain squalls
Cones with fine weather from N.W.
heading to the Eastward fitting Rigging
making Spinnaker with various jobs

Friday Aug 5th

Commenced with fine weather
from N.W. by N. Middle and latter
the same employed in the Rigging
making Spinnaker &c &c

overhauling and fitting Shot ropes
Cones with thick and foggy weather
from the Northward heading W.N. by S

Commenced with light breezes
and thick haze from the North
employed fitting Shot ropes
Cones with thick and raining
from the Eastward Heavy off
W. Shot sail
