 East Lat 31 47 S

Friday Jan 6th
 Commences with strong breezes
 and raining in squalls from
 E.S.W. heading to the North east sail
 in light to the Westward Onas
 with fresh breezes and fine weather
 from E.S.W. Coal Emporium Painting
 Ship out Side

Saturday Jan 7th
 Commences with fine
 weather from E.S.W. Onas with
 fresh breeze and fine weather
 light and baffling winds
 Lat 30 41 S

 Commences with light breeze from W
 heading to the Southward Onas
 with fine weather from W.S.W.
 heading to the S of the wind
 Lat 31. 34 S
 Long 179. 26 E

Monday Jan 9th
 Commences with fine weather
 from S.W. heading S.E. Onas with
 thick and raining from E
 No Sails

Tuesday Jan 10th
 Commences with thick and
 raining from S.E. heading to the
 Eastward Short Sail
 with strong breezes from N.E.
 Lat 32 41 S

Wednesday Jan 11th
 Commences with strong
 breezes and squally from the
 N with rain and squalls
 Onas with a fresh breeze from
 N to N.W. now to Short Sail
 Lat 32 46 S

Thursday Jan 12th
 Commences with fresh Sails
 from W head to Short Sail
 Middle masted Onas light breeze

Friday Jan 13th
 Commences light breeze from
 W at 4 pm Calm Onas with
 fine weather Sailed with the
 Osmanley
