Wednesday May 24th 1871

Commenced with a strong Gale and bad thick weather from N.W. Coast N.E. & E till 7 o'clock with lower main 1st sail and fore sail Middle Moderately under way to the N.W. Coast E.N.E. and N.E. by 11 o'clock moderate but kept the Hunter in sight

Thursday May 25th

Commenced with light Breezes from W and veering to N.W. Coasts N.E. by 11 o'clock all sail Middle strong Breezes from N.W. Coasts N.E. by 11 o'clock moderate and halting to N.W. by the wind to N.W. thick and cloudy

Friday May 26th

Commenced with thick and rainy from the Northward at 4 p.m. Calm and rainy at 7 p.m. light airs from the S. by N.W. the Hunter in sight a head Middle strong Breeze and squally from N.W. Coasts N.E. Coasts the same

Saturday May 27th

Commenced with heavy Squalls from W Coasts N. West sail Coasts with strong Breezes and squally from N.W. to W Coasts by the wind N.E.

Sunday May 28th 1871

Commenced with strong Breezes and squally from W and N.W. Coasting hard finds we have got about 45 days Bread in the Ship Breezes thick and squally from N.W. by the wind to the N.W. Coasting all the sail we can base on account of Bread

Monday May 29th

Commenced with a fresh Gale from N.W. and veering to W. Coasts N.E. by 11 o'clock single reefed 1st sails and Coasts Middle thick and rainy from W Coasts N.E. whole 1st sails

Tuesday May 30th

Commenced with fine pleasant weather from S.S.W. Sent up main trial board and set the sail for the first time the passage at 7 o'clock N.E. by 11 o'clock light Breezes from S Middle light Breeze & ends with light airs and Calms sent up the 1st Booms

Wednesday May 31st

Commenced with light airs and Calms at 4 p.m. fresh Breezes from N.W. heading N.E. by the wind all sail Put out the Bow and N. Boat Ends with fresh Breezes and thick Cloudy weather from the N heading E.N.E.
