Monday July 3th 1871
Commenced with fresh breezes
and squally from E. & S. heading
N by E. which all sail saw a
number of sails pass bound to the
S. Middle moderate weather wind
veering to E. & S. at daylight dead
calm at 10 am light breezes
from E course N all sail

Commenced with light breezes
and fine weather from E. & S. E.
course N by W all sail ends with
fine weather and fresh breezes from
E course N by W

all sail ends with fine weather
and fresh trades course N all
sail
