Friday July 21st 1871
Commenced with Squally and
Thunder Storm from S.E. Course
N.W. Middle light was from S.E.
Ends with a heavy Thunder Storm
and shifting to all parts of the
Compass No Obs

Saturday July 22nd
Commenced thick and raining
at 2 p.m. cleared up and a
light breeze from E.S.E. and
E.S.E. Course N.W. all sail
middle and latter very light
was from S.E. and E.S.E. Course
N.W. all sail finished painting
Ship out-side

Sunday July 23rd
Commenced with light
was from S.E. Course N.W.
at 5 p.m. veered to E.S.E.
Ends with light was from
S.E. Course N.W. all sail

Monday July 24th
Commenced with light
was from S.E. Course N.W. of
Ends with light breezes and
squally from S.E. Course N.W.
by N all sail

Tuesday July 25th 1871
Commenced with Squally with
heavy rain Course N.W. all
sail middle and latter squally
with heavy rain squally and
latter shift from all parts of
the compass Run over a
small Sperm Whale under
the jib boom before we saw
him only saw one

Run over
him with
the ship

Wednesday July 26th
Commenced with baffling
wind and squalls from all
parts of the compass middle
and latter stormy and
raining with Thunder and lightning

Ends with light was from
Course N.W. all sail

Friday July 28th
Commenced with light breeze

Course N and N.W. all sail
