S. W. by W. Lat: 08 14 0 North

Sat the 27th strong trades saw nothing
painted the main mast

Sunday the 28th a strong breeze and
squally saw nothing so goes

Mon the 29th strong breeze and squall
by with single reef top sails

Tues the 30th a strong breeze under
single reef top sails main top
gallant sail steering W. N. W. by W.

Thurs the 31st a strong breeze steering
S. W. by W. single reef top
sails and main top gallant
sail saw nothing mendi-
ing the main sail so goes
the month.
