Thurs the 25th the first part a light breeze
mostly calm in sight of the land
starting in for it the middle and
last part a good breeze got the
anchors of the boats at 8 P.M. let
go anchor and furled the sails
in the great part of Salcatuano
and the Capt went on shore so goes

Frie the 26th a light breeze in port all
hands employe in getting wood
and water 3 day in board

Sat the 27th in port the S Watch
on shore the S employe in
getting wood and making ship

Sunday the 28th in port the S Watch
on shore so goes

Mon the 29th in port the S Watch
on shore the S Watch employe
in getting wood and painting
ship

Tues the 30th in port the S Watch on
shore the S employe in
recruiting ship

Thurs the 1st in port the S Watch on shore

Thurs the 2nd in port the S Watch on shore

Frie the 3rd in port all hands on board bent
a new main top sail got up the
tack and wore the cat fall

Sat the 4th a good breeze here short and
bore the top sails at 3 P.M.
got under way and stowed the
anchors and chains for home

Sunday 5th a moderate breeze starting by
the wind saw a plenty of fin
backs and a school of black fish
saw a brig, starting to the north

Mon the 6th a good breeze starting by the
wind saw a plenty of fin backs
at 4 P.M. set hole at 4 P.M. lashed
ship to the south so goes it

Tues the 7th a good breeze starting by the wind
heaving S.E. but saw no whales
spoke the Barque Columbe of
Shen-Beeport Capt Davis 5 months
out 40 bbls of she is cutting so it goes
Lat 35° 8' south

Thurs the 8th a good breeze but some thick starting
by the wind saw a school of black fish
and some fin backs sent down the main
top gallant sail and mended it and sent
it up again & goes the time
