Sunday the 16th a strong breeze from
the S^E steering N^W by S^E
employed in boiling saw a
sail standing south at 11 P.M.
finished boiling so ended

Monday the 17th a good breeze steering
N^W by S^E employed in setting
up the main rigging & C saw

Tues the 18th a light breeze steering N^W
by S^E employed in storing down
oil saw nothing so goes

Wednes the 19th a light breeze steering
N^W by S^E employed in taring
down saw nothing

Thurs the 20th a light breeze steering
N^W employed in taring down
and painting spars & C saw nothing

Frid the 21st a light breeze steering N^W
employed in painting and
rattling down the rigging & sail
in sight saw some breaches but
I ges they was forfess do not know

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Sat the 22nd a strong double reef top sail breeze
steering N^W employed in strapping
locks and making scrub teeth saw a
brig standing S^E some rain to day

Sunday the 23rd a good breeze steering N^W
with thick weather and some rain
saw nothing but gulf weed

Monday the 24th a good breeze steering N^W
employed in washing ship
raining most part of the day

Tues the 25th a good breeze steering by the
wind employed in painting yards
but saw nothing Sat 26th 30th &

Thurs the 26th a light breeze steering by the
wind employed in washing ship and
rattling top mast rigging 2 sail in
sight last part wind N^W & steering S^E

Thurs the 27th a light breeze steering N^W by S^E
employed in painting ship
saw nothing these 24 hours

Frid the 28th a good breeze steering N^W
by S^E employed in rattling and
painting saw nothing

Sat the 29th a light breeze steering N^W
employed in painting ship
saw a pump back & sail in sight

Sunday the 30th a light breeze steering N^W
slow hauler saw nothing
