on the 28th of May 1873.

We left the wharf at
 $\frac{1}{2}$ past 10 got as far as
Clark's point and a
fog shut in very thick
but we kept on and
at about $\frac{1}{2}$ past 12 o'clock
we saw Quick's Hole
went through all night.
at $\frac{1}{4}$ of 1 o'clock the
steamerboat left us
as soon as we got
