

Tues. Aug 11th 1844.
Lat. 36. 49 N. Lon. 38. 13 W
Commences with a light
breeze from the East
and continues so
through the day.
After supper I fished
and caught a skip-
jack out of the waist
boat.

No sails in sight
through the day. I
have caught the
only fish that
has been caught
this voyage so
certainly I am no
detriment to the voyage.

Wed. Aug 13th 1844.
Lat. 36. 36 N. Lon. 37. 58 W
Commences with a strong
breeze from the N. W.
and continues so
until afternoon when
it died away to a
calm. After supper
we lowered away
all four boats and
let them pull away
for exercise as the
men are almost all
green, they pulled
until almost dark
& we hoisted a signal
to come to the ship they
had a race coming won by
the waist boat. Mr. Williams
