Lat. 39.41 N. Long. 31.34 W.
Commences with a light
breeze from the N. at
daylight this morning
land was raised
is was Flores and
now we can see
it very plainly.
We cruised off here
all day and at
night we stood
off to sea out the
way of land but
expect to be back
to morrow morning
to go on shore.

Sunday Aug 30th 1874.
Lat. 39.44 N. Long. 31.18 W.
Off. Carvo. Islands.
Commences with light
breeze from the N. and
and increasing. We
being quite near
Carvo we ran down
close to land. at
12 p.m. lowered away
the ~~waist~~ boat and
went ashore and
stayed until 5 p.m.
when we came off
to the ship again.
They were all Port-
uguese but some
could talk English.
