Lat. 37.09. Lon. 63.45
Commences with a
gale of wind from the
N. and we are under
topsails & courses about
two points free. At a-
bout 12 O'clock we saw
a ship bound to the E.
under same sail as we are.
In the afternoon
about 3 O'clock we
saw a steamship and
a bark bound to
Europe we thought
the steamship was
from Baltimore by
the way she was steering
