While Cruising in N. Atlantic Ocean after Sp. Cet

July 24th 63 Thursday 24th Con. with fresh rain from N. N. W. the Ship in chase of Spine Whales to the rain around going quick at 1 P. M. the whales killed 2 from the particular course the three Carboara boats at 2 P. M. the West boat struck one and the crew came out boat close him at 4 P. M. the Carboara boat struck one and look him along side at 6 P. M. and got supper at 7 P. M. and set the boats to Midair part Light rain from N. W. and a heavy swell at half past 3 A. M. call all hands at 4 A. M. hooked on and commenced to get steering. S. E. by compass under bare poles a cutting Latter part light air from N. W. steering S. E. with every thing forced a heavy swell from N. W. and bad cutting Lat 48° 34' N Long 21° 37' W

July 25th 64 Friday 25th Con. with light rain and pleasant but a heavy swell from N. W. steering S. E. at 5 P. M. hove the crew overboard and cleared up the Deck at all hands got supper at 9 P. M. set the watch ready some said steering N. N. W. Midair part rain S. W. and rain the watch employed in cutting up the Deck Latter part rain N. N. W. by compass some rain squalls the Ship on the Northw tack at 9 A. M. started the works Lat 49° 46' N Long 22° 10' W

July 26th 65 Saturday 26th Con. with fresh rain from N. N. W. some squalls of rain the Ship on the Northw tack Boiling Middle part fresh rain from N. at 11 A. M. were Ship taken over to N. W. Latter part light air and calm - boiling

July 27th 66 Sunday 27th Con. with light rain from S. and rain the Ship on the Western tack Boiling nothing in sight but the rain pouring to the N. W. fog and rain Midair part light rain from N. S. W. and fog at 11 A. M. light rain from N. S. W. the Ship on opposite tack Boiling Latter part rain and fog fresh rain from the S. W. at 11 A. M. finer boiling the Ship under easy sail saw nothing the Steerage Log id. better rain on the evening tack I think he will get well now if nothing happens to him but he is very weak and open Cloudy
