 230 *Tuesday 6th* Con. with light breeze from S. N. the ship on the Western tack at 4 P. M. calms at 5 P. M. light breeze from N steering N. S. W. at 9 P. M. took in sail steering S by E. Made part light gales from N E at 4 A. M. made some sail steering N. S. W. at 5 A. M. made the land bearing 110 miles latter part rain and weather changeable the ship working in towards the land in morning but the land Lat 48° 33' S Long 65° 31' W

231 *Wednesday 7th* Con. with variable breeze and weather some rain in squalls and a little of all sorts the ship working to the South along the land taking in sail night. Made part fresh breeze from S. N. the ship on the E tack under easy sail. Latter part light gales from N to N. S. W. steering S by E. Clear weather and a squall of rain and wind. There had Bk. found some head a bad coughing spell this morning Lat 49° 40' S Long 66° 40' W

232 *Thursday 8th* Con. with fresh breeze from N. N. steering S. S. W. at 3 P. M. changed the course S by W and the wind all day out to a calm nothing in sight. Made part fresh breeze from the N. S. W. the ship on the E tack. Latter part light gales from S. N. and the N. Lat 50° 31' S Long 66° 31' W

233 *Friday 9th* Con. with light gale from N. S. W. and the ship on the E tack. Made part fresh breeze from N. S. W. the ship laying hove to on opposite tacks under close reef. Main top sail quite cold weather Lat 51° 00' S Long 65° 03' W

234 *Saturday 10th* Con. with light gales from N. S. W. at 1 P. M. made some sail the ship on the N and Western tack at 4 P. M. the wind calms some to N. S. and North wave more still. Made part light air and calms. Latter part light breeze from N. S. W. the ship on the S. S. W. and Western tack under all sail fine weather caught a Sperm whale after a long time Lat 51° 24' S Long 65° 31' W

N. good weather at 4 A. M. made Cape Horn. Latter part light air and calms the ship of shore 10 miles and a boat 10 miles South of the River Gallegos see nothing Lat 52° 08' S
