

Remarks Pass On Board Bk. Ocean N. Bedford on a Whaling

March 1880

300 Tuesday 16th Comm. with fresh Laid from N.W. steering S. & N. under double reef top sails and fore sail smoky weather at sunrise took in sail came to on the North and Eastern tack. Midale and Latter part fresh wind from North at daylight made some sail at 7 A.M. steering S. cloudy overcast at 10 A.M. rain going to the North quick at 11 A.M. saw two more a fishing. Four all 4 boats but did not see them again but think they have gone North. Lat 46° 44' Long 61° 20' W

Cabin Boy off deck his finger

301 Wednesday 17th Comm. with fresh wind from N. the ship and short tacks with top of sea in more. Whales Midale and Latter part light wind from N. and good weather but cloudy at 8 A.M. four boats. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W

302 Thursday 18th Comm. with calm at 3 P.M. light wind from S. N. W. Good weather at 5 P.M. four boats for B. Whales at sunrise the second Mate struck wood when he was commencing on board Midale part came. Latter part light wind from all points of the compass at 11 P.M. took the whale along side and got supper and set the watch. Latter part fine weather wind S. W. at 8 A.M. commenced to cut so ends a cutting. Lat 47° 01' S Long 61° 07' W

303 Friday 19th Comm. with fresh gales from N. W. steering S. & N. under double reef top sails and fore sail smoky weather at sunrise took in sail came to on the North and Eastern tack. Midale and Latter part fresh wind from North at daylight made some sail at 7 A.M. steering S. cloudy overcast at 10 A.M. rain going to the North quick at 11 A.M. saw two more a fishing. Four all 4 boats but did not see them again but think they have gone North. Lat 46° 44' Long 61° 20' W

304 Saturday 20th Comm. with fresh wind from N. N. W. ship on the North and Western tack under double reef top sails. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W

304 Saturday 20th Comm. with fresh wind from N. N. W. ship on the North and Western tack under double reef top sails. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W

305 Sunday 21st Comm. with light Laid from S. the ship on the Western tack under double reef top sails. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W

306 Monday 22nd Comm. with fresh wind from N. N. W. at 3 P.M. luffed to on North and Eastern tack at 4 P.M. commenced to rain took in same sail and cooled down. Midale part wind from S. & E. the ship on opposite tacks. Latter part light wind from N. and fine. Beautiful weather at 7 A.M. started the works the ship under all sail. Lat 46° 00' S Long 61° 07' W

307 Tuesday 23rd Comm. with fine breeze from N. N. W. the ship on the North and Eastern tack under all sail a Boiling at 5 P.M. took in sail and got supper and set the watch nothing in sight. Midale part at 11 P.M. finished Boiling with Laid from S. & N. Latter part the same area heavy squalls with Hale ship on N. tack. Lat 46° 20' S Long 61° 07' W

308 Wednesday 24th Comm. with fresh Laid from S. & N. and heavy squalls with Hale the ship on the Western tack. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W

309 Thursday 25th Comm. with fresh wind from N. N. W. ship on the North and Western tack under double reef top sails. Latter part light wind from N. and chased them all the forenoon but found them very wild came on board at 11 Lat 47° 00' W Long 61° 30' W
