

Remarks Pass On Board Bk Ocean N. Bedford, Mass. Whaling 1880

541 Sunday 14th Calm, with light wind from N. the ship on the Meteor tack under all sail Middle part the same Latter part light Calm from N and clear weather Lat 40° 15' S Long 49° 35' W

542 Monday 15th Calm, with light Calm from N and N the ship on opposite tack with clear weather Middle and Latter part the same Putting one of the boats on the house the boat on the same quite a number of Humpbacks Lat 40° 21' S Long 49° 32' W

543 Tuesday 16th Calm, with light Calm from N and N the ship on opposite tack with clear weather Middle and Latter part fresh Calm from S and heavy squalls of Gale and rain Lat 39° 33' S Long 50° 33' W

544 Wednesday 17th Calm, with fresh Calm from S and fresh Calm S the ship on the North and Meteor tack with storm & heavy squalls some heavy squalls of Gale & rain and rain Lat 38° 50' S Long 50° 33' W

545 Thursday 18th Calm, with fresh Calm from S to S and some squalls but so many as yesterday the weather improving a little ship under close reef top sails on the North & Meteor tack Middle and Latter part moderate Calm S & N S the ship on the North and Meteor tack clear weather Lat 37° 52' S Long 50° 45' W

546 Friday 19th Calm, with moderate Calm from N the ship on the South and Meteor tack Middle & Latter part moderate Calm from N the ship on the South and Meteor tack at 10 AM moderate made sail Lat 38° 52' S Long 50° 39' W

547 Saturday 20th Calm, with light wind from N the ship on the Southern tack under all sail the mate took it upon himself to give the men Forward Molasses Middle and Latter part Calm from N. N. W clear Lat 39° 17' S Long 51° 42' W

548 Sunday 21st Calm, with fresh Calm from N. N. W ship on the Meteor tack lagging too under storm sails Middle part some thunder and lightning Latter part moderate Calm from N the ship on the Meteor tack and clear weather & lightning a heavy swell Lat 38° 22' S Long 51° 50' W

Voyage While Cruising On Patagonia Bk & Spirit Whaling 1880

549 Monday 22nd Calm, with moderate Calm from S. E. W the ship on the Meteor tack at 2 PM made some sail Middle part light air & calm Latter part moderate Calm S. N. the ship on the S & Meteor tack clear weather Lat 38° 34' S Long 53° 40' W

550 Tuesday 23rd Calm, with moderate Calm S. N. and N the ship on the S & Meteor tack at 4 PM moderate some made some sail ship still on the S & Meteor tack at 4 PM caught a Poppois and a number of Furbacks Middle and Latter part light wind from S. N. W the ship on opposite tack cloudy overcast all day No Sun

551 Wednesday 24th Calm, with fine breeze from S. N. W and N ship on the Meteor tack saw a plenty of Furbacks at sundown took in sail for the night and more ship to the Eastward Middle and Latter part light wind from the North & Eastward some rain squalls cloudy and Sunshine at times the Cooper employed turning Belagius Fish Lat 38° 42' S Long 55° 34' W

552 Thursday 25th Calm, with light air and calm a few light passing rain squalls at 4 PM some rain and some bottom in 60 Fathom of water Middle and Latter part fresh wind from S & cloudy weather the ship on opposite tack one Merchant ship in sight bound Lat 38° 35' S Long 55° 40' W

553 Friday 26th Calm, with light wind from South the ship on opposite tack nothing in sight at sundown took in sail Middle part light air and calm Latter part light wind from North at 8 AM spoke bark George & Susan of N. B. 2 Whales the season reports the rest of the ships having one and two Whales heads seen a number of Whales for a few days head a line steering to the south and Westward and South and Eastward in company No Sun

554 Saturday 27th Calm, with fresh wind from S. N. W steering different courses looking for Whales saw a plenty of Humpbacks and Poppois at dark took in sail at 9 PM broke up the gun but still in company Middle part the same Latter part light air and calm some rain at 10 AM wind from S. E. some fog and rain ship on the Meteor tack the Bk. Susan in company Lat 39° 31' W Long 55° 50' S
