

Remarks Pass On Board 73rd Ocean St. Bedford on a Whaling

Aug. 1881

611 Monday 3rd Com. with light Calcs from N.N.W. ship on opposite tacks at 7 P.M. came in thick fog. Middle the same. Latter fine breeze from S.E. & E. and good whale weather a cloudy overcast the most of the time ship under all sail steering different courses see quite a number of Finbacks Lat 47° 36'

612 Tuesday 25th Com. with fine breeze from E. & E. to E. steering different courses ship under all sail Middle and Latter light Calcs from N.E. Fog and rain no sun

613 Wednesday 26th Com. with moderate Calcs from N.N.E. against at 3 P.M. the fog lifted made some sail steering S.E. and S. by E. Middle and Latter part fine winds from N to N.W. good whale weather ship on opposite tacks see a few Porpoises and Finbacks Lat 47° 42' S Long 56° 28' W

614 Thursday 27th Com. with fine breeze from N.W. ship on the Western tack at 3 P.M. came in a fog the ship under all sail caught a Porpoise and killed one of the Eggs and broke out Flour Middle and Latter part light air from all points of the compass and fog employed in breaking out Provision in the After Hold at 11 A.M. fog lifted soon Lat 47° 44' S Long 57° 38' W

615 Friday 28th Com. with light wind S.E. steering N.E. by N the Watch employed in breaking out in the After Hold for Provisions at 3 P.M. came in a thick fog Middle fog and rain Latter part light wind from S.E. and E. fine weather the ship on Northern tack see nothing Lat 47° 20' S Long 57° 08' W

616 Saturday 29th Com. with light wind from the Southern and Western board steering N.W. beautiful weather Middle and Latter fresh wind N.N.W. some rain squalls ship on opposite tacks under easy sail Lat 47° 26' S Long 57° 10' W

617 Sunday 30th Com. with strong breeze from N.N.W. the wind blowing to the Westward ship under all sail Middle light wind from N to N.W. Latter part strong wind from N.E. to E. and fresh wind in squalls of Hale and rain and some thunder the weather looking mild for a short time Glass 28° 9' this No Sun

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618 Monday 31st Com. with Fresh Calcs N.W. working Calcs 8 Nestled and clear weather Middle and Latter part clear N.N.W. Fresh Calcs N and rain squalls at 10 A.M. the eye ball in main top sail the main top sail came broke that the brace hook into the brace broke Port Barce Arw but done no further damage

619 Tuesday 1st Com. with fresh Calcs from N & N to S.W. Calcs with ship on the North and Western tack some rain squalls Middle Calcs from S.S.W. and a high sea Latter moderate light Calcs and clear weather ship on the W tack Lat 45° 56' S Long 57° 40' W

620 Wednesday 2nd Com. with moderate Calcs from N.W. and clear weather ship on the North and Western tack at 4 P.M. noon ship to the Southward Middle and Latter part light Calcs from N a few passing rain squalls at 9 A.M. set fore sail steering S.E. by E a heavy swell from N Lat 45° 38' S Long 56° 38' W

621 Thursday 3rd Com. with light Calcs from West steering N.E. by N at 3 P.M. lifted to the wind on the Northern tack Middle and Latter part fine wind N.W. ship under all sail steering N by W heavy swell from N nothing in sight Lat 44° 49' S Long 56° 32' W

622 Friday 4th Com. with fine breeze from N.N.W. steering N under Fresh Calcs all sail with good weather and at sun down took in sail with rain Middle the same Latter part fresh Calcs N ship on the Northern tack some rain in squalls a bad sea at times Lat 44° 05' S Long 56° 32' W

623 Saturday 5th Com. with fresh Calcs from S.S.W. and a bad sea ship on North & Western tack Middle moderate Calcs Latter part light Calcs and rain ship on the Western tack No Sun

624 Sunday 6th Com. with strong breeze S.S.W. ship on opposite tacks broke out meat & Flour Middle and Latter part fresh wind from N.W. ship on opposite tacks Lat 43° 05' S Long 57° 10' W

625 Monday 7th Com. with strong winds N to S.W. ship on opposite tacks clear weather Middle part light wind N & calm Latter part fine wind from N and cloudy some rain steering N.N.W. wind increasing watch employed in breaking out for water & Molasses. see Nothing Lat 43° 23' S Long 57° 58' W
