

Remarks Pass On Board Bk. Ocean N. Bedford On. Whaling Voyage
Feb. 1881

637 Sunday 20th Calm. with light winds from N to N.W. heavy smoke from N and thick smoke weather ship under easy sail Middle calm. Latter Calm some rain and thunder wind from N to N.W. unpleasant weather Lat 45° 48' S Long 69° 28' W

639 Monday 21st Calm. with light winds from N.W. and N.W. ship on the South and Western tack middle part calm. Latter part light wind S & thick fog steering N by W at 10 AM the fog lifted and made some sail Lat 45° 36' S Long 69° 14' W

640 Tuesday 22nd Calm. with light winds S & steering N cloudy weather at 1 P.M. found a bottom in 10 fathoms Middle part light wind from E. & S. Latter part strong breeze and light Calm from E to N & steering different courses saw a Merchant Bk. bound South Lat 45° 33' S Long 61° 50' W

641 Wednesday 23rd Calm. with light winds from N & the ship on the North Western tack cloudy weather Middle part light winds from N plenty of Thunder & lightning & rain Latter part strong breeze from N and cloudy haze weather see nothing but Long faces Lat 45° 45' S Long 62° 12' W

642 Thursday 24th Calm. with fresh breeze from N to N.W. by N thick haze weather quite a swell from N & Middle and Latter part light North & Easterly winds and thick fog washing ships Lat 45° 45' S Long 62° 12' W

643 Friday 25th Calm. with light airs North and Easterly thick fog all the time Middle the same Latter strong wind S & and rain steering N under easy sail unpleasant No Sun

644 Saturday 26th Calm. with fresh winds E & ship on the N and E tack it raining the most of the time Middle the same Latter part light Easterly winds and fog caught some No Sun

645 Sunday 27th Calm. with light airs from the E and fog middle part light airs from N steering S & plenty of fog Latter part light winds N.W. and Partally clear steering S & saw a Merchant Bk. bound South Home route Home how long to see how Lat 45° 35' S Long 61° 51' W

March 1881

646 Monday 28th Calm. with light winds N.W. clear at 3 P.M. sent a boat on board of the English Bk. Carmelita of Falkland 44 days from Braamisa bound to Eschilla Shide and sent letters by her J. Griffiths Master Middle the same Latter part light winds from S.W. at 9 AM passed close to a Brit. bark bound South. no fog but clearing over east ship under all sail No Sun

647 Tuesday 1st Calm. with light winds S.W. and South ship on cloudy weather the Master tack under all sail cloudy weather too Merchant vessels good weather in sight Middle calm and air from the N.W. Latter part fresh saw 2 hulk, wind N.W. and N steering S & under all sail Latter 46° 26' S Long 61° 27' W

648 Wednesday 2nd Calm. with fresh winds S.W. the ship on the South coast weather tack see nothing but Pippins at sundown took in sail Middle 8 Light Calm Latter part fresh winds light winds from N to S.W. and clear weather weather see nothing but Pippins and other faces Lat 47° 10' S Long 61° 22' W

649 Thursday 3rd Calm. with fresh winds N.W. ship on the North coast weather tack at sundown took in sail Middle the same Latter part light winds N.W. fine weather ship on different tack Lat 46° 36' S Long 61° 16' W

650 Friday 4th Calm. with light winds N.W. and N.W. ship on the North coast tack under all sail at sundown took in sail Middle and Latter strong winds N.W. and N.W. see nothing Lat 46° 13' S Long 61° 31' W

651 Saturday 5th Calm. with fresh winds S.W. ship on the North coast a much and Western tack at sundown took in sail Middle strong winds S.W. Latter fresh winds S.W. and N.W. Lat 46° 19' S Long 61° 01' W

652 Sunday 6th Calm. with fresh winds N.W. N.W. ship on the North coast and Eastern tack at sundown took in sail Middle and Latter strong winds from N.W. and N.W. the ship on different tack see nothing the prospect looking very unfavorable Lat 45° 28' S Long 60° 55' W

653 Monday 7th Calm. with fresh winds from S.W. ship on the North coast opposite tack at sundown took in sail Middle and Latter part light winds from all points of the compass light Calm a heavy swell at 8 AM took a strong breeze from S and S.E. took in light sails the wind still increasing Lat 45° 24' S Long 61° 45' W
