

Remarks Pursued on Board Bk. Ocean N. Bedford on a Whaling voyage March 1881

654 Tuesday 8th Com. with light gales from South ship on opposite tack at sundown took in sail Middle light wind Latter part fresh gales from N.W. & West Lat 45° 35' S Long 61° 44' W

655 Wednesday 9th Com. with light gales from N ship on the North tack saw a Whale Bk. at 6 P.M. spoke the Bk. Chig. A. B. Ellis head got nothing since last report Middle and Latter part light wind from N to N.W. ship steering different Lat 45° 31' S Long 61° 58' W

656 Thursday 10th Com. with light wind from N steering different courses pleasant weather Middle strong wind N.W. and Latter part strong wind N Lat 46° 14' S Long 61° 46' W

657 Friday 11th Com. with light wind from N ship on the North tack fair weather at sundown took in sail Middle light gales from South Latter part strong wind S.E. Lat 45° 44' S Long 62° 35' W

658 Saturday 12th Com. with fresh breezes from E. morning light gales Northward at 4 P.M. more ship S.E. heavy swell from the East caught a whale at sundown took in sail Middle and Latter part light gales from N.E. to N.W. cloudy hazy weather Lat 46° 06' S Long 63° 06'

659 Sunday 13th Com. with winds from N.W. and West ship on the North tack Middle and Latter part fine breezes from N to N.W. good weather ship on opposite tack Lat 46° 32' S Long 61° 11' W

660 Monday 14th Com. with light wind N.W. and N.W. ship fine weather on opposite tack fine weather Middle light wind from South Repairing and East masts Latter part light wind from N.W. to N.W. Fore sail steering East employed in Repairing Fore sail Lat 46° 33' S Long 61° 13' W

661 Tuesday 15th Com. with light wind from N.W. to N.W. saw a hump steering E. saw a merchant Bk. bound S. the watch employed in Bk. bound Repairing Fore sail Middle calm and Light air from North steering E. and Latter part fine breezes from N steering E Lat 45° 46' S Long 59° 00' W

662 Wednesday 16th Com. with fresh breezes from N ship on the N.W. tack Middle light gales N Latter part moderate wind N.W. Lat 45° 54' S Long 60° 51' W

663 Thursday 17th Com. with fresh wind N.W. steering S.W. by S and smoky weather by N Middle some thunder and light wind in the West and Repairing board Latter part light wind from N.W. ship on the North tack Fore top sail pleasant weather see nothing Lat 46° 05' S Long 60° 36' W

664 Friday 18th Com. with light wind from N.W. ship on the saw 3 hump North and East tack Middle part wind N.W. and N.W. Latter part light gales S.W. steering N half E see nothing Lat 44° 44' S Long 59° 57' W

665 Saturday 19th Com. with light gales S.W. steering N half E and N.W. part a Whaling Schooner and merchant Bk. bound South Middle light wind S.E. to S.E. Latter part fresh wind E and N.E. saw plenty of Pinnucks Lat 43° 57' S Long 59° 34' W

666 Sunday 20th Com. with light gales N.E. ship on opposite tack saw 3 hump clear weather Middle and Latter part the same the wind Bk. bound in the North and East masts bound at 11 A.M. thick fog South No Sun

667 Monday 21th Com. with fresh wind and a thick fog wind North ship on opposite tack Middle strong wind N and clear weather Latter part light gales N the wind working N.W. ship on opposite tack Lat 43° 47' S Long 59° 40' W

668 Tuesday 22th Com. with light gales N.W. steering N.W. by E clear weather at 3 P.M. more ship to the North and set a whale the Fore top sail wind moderate Middle and Latter part light wind from the South and West masts at daylight made a light wind all sail steering N by E half E at 6 A.M. raised a Whale going quick to the South masts called it a Pile Whale but nothing but nothing shun about it fine pleasant weather Lat 43° 15' S Long 59° 11' W

669 Wednesday 23th Com. with light breezes from South morning fine weather Easterly steering N by E and Middle and Latter part wind from E to N.E. to N.E. good weather ship on opposite tack Lat 42° 36' S

670 Thursday 24th Com. with fresh wind N.E. cloudy weather rain & cloudy at 3 P.M. some rain the wind died out to a calm Middle part some thunder some rain with thunder and lightning wind N steering N.E. and lightning Latter part light wind from N.W. ship on the North tack and East tack under all sail see nothing Lat 42° 15' S Long 58° 11' W
