

Remarks Pass On Board Bk. Ocean N. Bedford On A. Whaling voyage

July 1881
795 Wednesday 27th Brou. with light breezes from S to SW steering N by N & N by W saw a few seals bound & saw with some birds middle and latter windward and with rain and fog pleasant weather. No sun

796 Thursday 28th Brou. with light Gale SW and W rain and fog at 4 P M broke for cup in stove still a boiling middle part the same latter fresh wind as N and clear the most of the time saw a number of M. Whales Lat 49° 08' Long 33° 18' W

797 Friday 29th Brou. with fine breezes from N and N. W. and fair weather for the Race saw a number of M. Whales middle and latter part fresh wind as from N. & W. the ship on opposite tack cloudy weather. No sun

798 Saturday 30th Brou. with light Gales N. N. W. some rain ship on opposite tack middle the same at 5 P M commenced slow down in rain to catch latter part the same at 8 P M the Bk. Com. Morris N. B. spoke us and made a haul rain & fog No sun

799 Sunday 31st Brou. with light Gales N steering to the North at 3 P M. and Metard some rain and fog still driving with both ships Brou. Morris and storing Oil at 4 P M both ships Mated mated and lowered the Carabara Boats for S. Whales at 7 P M. the Brou. Morris boats took out along side took up the boats and Finnish storing down at 9 P M middle fresh Gales N at 4 A M moderate at 5 A M went on board Brou. Morris to help him out latter fine weather and light wind cutti at 11 A M spoke Bk. Lagoda 500 Spirit the same Lat 49° 30' N Long 33° 26' W

800 Monday 1st Brou. with calms at 6 P M finish cutting it still a calm over the Ocean 12 miles off middle at mid night light airs from N at half past one o'clock mated the boat and started for home at 5 A M got on board latter part fresh Gales from SW with rain No sun

801 Tuesday 2nd Brou. fresh Gales SW and rain ship on opposite tack middle the same latter light Gales W and heavy swell N. W. saw a number of Whales the most Lat 49° 33' N part of the time clear some light rain squalls Long 33° 27' W

In The Atlantic Ocean While Crossing On Brou. Morris Ground

802 Wednesday 3rd Brou. with light Gales N the ship on the southern tack saw a number of seals heavy swell middle light Gales all over day. S. W. rain a fog latter the same employment making ship Lat 49° 33' N

803 Thursday 4th Brou. with fresh Gales S. W. rain and fog ship on opposite tack middle and latter part light Gales N to W clear the most of the time Lat 49° 38' N Long 33° 23' W

804 Friday 5th Brou. with fresh Gales W and N. W. the ship on the South and Meteor tack middle the same latter part light Gales from N. N. W. cloudy over east saw Pinbacks 81 Brig. No sun

805 Saturday 6th Brou. with light Gales N at 3 P M came in fog and rain ship on opposite tack middle and latter part fresh wind N fog and rain at 7 P M. saw and heard a whale spout close to the ship called it a spirit whale ship on short tack but see nothing but Pinbacks 81 P. P. Lat 49° 36' N

806 Sunday 7th Brou. with fresh wind from N the ship on opposite tack thick weather some rain & fog squa middle the same latter part thick weather foggy the most of the time at 9 A M spoke the Bk. Com. Morris and heard a haul saw the Reineau N. N. to N. N. W. Lat: 49° 25' N Long 31° 16' W

807 Monday 8th Brou. fresh wind N. N. W. to N. N. W. some fog at 6 P M broke at 6 P M broke up the haul and came in board at sundown up the haul took in sail for night foggy and rainy weather middle foggy and rain latter part light Gales from the N & clear Lat 49° 16' N Long 31° 20' W

808 Tuesday 9th Brou. fresh wind N and clear heavy sea caught 2 P. P. from N. N. saw Black Fish and P. P. P. P. middle pleasant latter light Gales N. N. W. and fog the ship on opposite tack Lat 49° 34' N

809 Wednesday 10th Brou. light Gales N and fog ship working to the Westward middle & latter steady breezes N. N. W. to N. N. W. thick weather with fog the most of the time ship tack & tack off

810 Thursday 11th Brou. fresh breezes N. N. W. fog ship working N. N. W. at 7 P M. lowered 3 boats for a H. whale but it calmed in fog did not see him again middle & latter weather the same Lat 49° 44' N Long 33° 23' W
