 811 Friday 12th Cow. with light Calcs N.W. thick fog the
 most part of the time ship on opposite tacks Middle the
 same Latter light air and calm rain & fog saw 4 fessels
 No Sun
 812 Saturday 13th Cow. with light air and calm rain and
 Fog Middle and Latter part light rain as N.W. some fog in
 squalls steering different courses but see nothing Lat 49° 41' N
 Long 23° 08' W
 813 Sunday 14th Cow. with light breezes N.W. and very smooth for
 cooper-cupping this country some fog squalls steering different courses
 in coming but see nothing but the backs Middle and Latter part rain
 dead N.W. and thick fog and rain ship under easy easy sail
 Lat 49° 36' N
 814 Monday 15th Cow. with light rain N.W. and thick
 Fog Middle the same Latter light rain as N.W. some
 rain and Fog at 8 A.M. lower a boat and tried to spare a steam
 barrow & ship ship but she would not stop for the boat Lat 49° 44' N
 Long 23° 20' W
 815 Tuesday 16th Cow. with light rain N.W. some rain and
 saw a whale Fog saw on whale ship thought her to be a whaling but it was
 Bk. caught false report ship under all sail Middle calm Latter light
 a Dippole wind E. & E. & E. some rain and foggy sea a few fessels
 No Sun
 816 Wednesday 17th Cow. with light wind E. & E. steering different
 courses to the N.W. rain and fog Middle and Latter the
 same steering N.W. and N.W. at 11 A.M. saw the cutter Morris and
 Reindeer took each a whale along side rain & fog the most of
 the day
 817 Thursday 18th Cow. with fresh wind from E. with rain &
 rain & fog Fog both Bk in sight at takes a cutting Middle the same Latter
 fresh wind from N. a few passing rain squalls Lat 49° 47' N
 Long 24° 05' W
 818 Friday 19th Cow. with fresh wind N. and clear the most
 of the time saw a number of fessels Middle light wind N.W.
 Latter the same a few rain squalls at 9 A.M. saw the cutter
 Morris a whaling distant about 8 miles at 10 A.M. rain
 the whales loy 3 Boats to cut the whales off at 11 A.M.
 the Morris boat struck so ends this day all four boats
 chasing galled whales and 3 boats from the Lat 49° 38' N
 Reindeer. May kind Fortune smile on the Ocean Long 24° 24' W

On The Atlantic Ocean While Cruising on Board Morris Crooked
 Aug 1881
 819 Saturday 20th Cow. with light baffling rain from South
 and Westward with squalls of rain at 3 P.M. the boats
 all came on board the whales going quick to the mainmast and
 it came in rain Middle and Latter part fresh wind from N. to
 saw spirit N.W. some rain squalls at 6 A.M. lower four boats for spirit whales
 the whales being close to the Bk. Reindeer and two miles from
 Reindeer to the Ocean the Reindeer boats soon struck and that galled all of them
 took 3 whales at 10 A.M. took up the boats with heavy hearts as this is the third
 time the same thing has happened when will our turn come
 and why are we so unfortunate Lat 49° 40' N
 Long 24° 00' W
 820 Sunday 21th Cow. with fresh wind from N. to N.W. some rain
 squalls ship on opposite tacks see nothing but fessels Middle
 and light air and calm a few passing rain squalls Lat 49° 30' N
 Long 24° 26' W
 821 Monday 22th Cow. with fresh wind from N. ship on opposite
 tacks the Reindeer in sight a cutting and a cutter Morris a whaling
 Middle fresh wind from N. and Latter fine wind
 from N. and E. fine weather see nothing Lat 49° 28' N
 Long 24° 37' W
 822 Tuesday 23th Cow. with light breezes from N. to E. ship on
 opposite tacks Middle the same Latter fresh wind from N. to N.W.
 and rain a pleasant weather saw a few fessels
 No Sun
 823 Wednesday 24th Cow. with strong wind N. with rain the
 ship on opposite tacks Middle & Latter wind from N. to N.W.
 N.W. blowing a moderate Gale with fog and rain No Sun
 824 Thursday 25th Cow. with moderate Calcs N.W. to N. N.W.
 rain and fog most all of the time Middle wind N. to N.W.
 and clear Latter the same saw a number of fessels Lat 49° 30' N
 Long 24° 03' W
 825 Friday 26th Cow. with moderate Calcs N.W. with squalls
 of rain Middle & Latter fresh Calcs N.W. & N.W. with fresh squalls
 of rain both and rain ship on the eastern tack Lat 49° 42' N
 Long 23° 51' W
 826 Saturday 27th Cow. with moderate Calcs N. ship on opposite tacks
 Middle part light wind from N. and good weather
 Latter fresh wind N.W. and some rain at 11 A.M. spoke
 the Cow. Morris and had a gun No Sun
