

Remarks: Put On Board 13k. Ocean N. Bedford On A Whaling Voyage

Aug. 8 Sept. 1881
828 Sunday 28th Comm. with fresh Calcs S. E. at 1 P. M. broke up ships leak the Calcs at 3 P. M. ship under close reef main top sail fresh Calcs with rain middle moderate Calcs in fog and rain latter fresh Calcs and rain equalled

829 Monday 29th Comm. with moderate Calcs and rain thick weather the most of the time ship on opposite tack middle the same latter part light Calcs from N and clear Lat 49° 38' N Long 23° 53' W

830 Tuesday 30th Comm. with fresh wind and clear steering different courses see nothing but fresh heavy swell middle at 6 P. M. miss a large sperm whale lower 3 boats came out dark did not see him again latter part fresh winds from south ship on opposite tack see nothing more of the whale Lat 49° 30' N

831 Wednesday 31st Comm. with light Calcs at 4 P. M. came in to rain and fog middle fresh Calcs with rain latter light rain and fog heavy swell Lat 49° 30' N

832 Thursday 1st Comm. with light wind and N rain Calcs and fog a heavy swell middle and latter light air and heavy swell Calcs from all points of compass heavy swell Lat 49° 24' N Long 24° 46' W

833 Friday 2nd Comm. with light winds N E ship on the South and Easton tack heavy swell N W middle and latter part fresh wind N and a heavy swell from N W ship on the Easton tack Lat 49° 10' N

834 Saturday 3rd Comm. with fresh winds N and a heavy swell N W ship on the Easton tack saw a few vessels under N middle and latter fresh winds from N E to N and rain ship on the Western tack under easy sail Lat 49° 10' N Long 23° 53' W

835 Sunday 4th Comm. with fresh winds N and N E the ship under Western tack some rain middle the same latter part fresh Calcs N W with equalled wind and rain Lat 49° 07' N Long 24° 27' W

836 Monday 5th Comm. with fresh Calcs N W ship on opposite fresh Calcs tacks fresh equalled of rain middle and latter part the N W with same saw a few vessels under Eastward Lat 48° 48' N Long 23° 50' W

On The Atlantic Ocean Bound South from Comm. Morris Ground

837 Tuesday 6th Comm. with light Calcs N heavy swell from N W ship on the Western tack cloudy weather some rain equalled middle and latter the same see nothing Lat 48° 30' N Long 26° 18' W

838 Wednesday 7th Comm. with fresh wind and some light rain ship on the Western tack steering N W by N wind N E middle and latter fine weather wind N E steering N W by N under all sail Lat 48° 21' N Long 29° 30' W

839 Thursday 8th Comm. with light breezes and very smooth for this fine wind under all sail steering N W by N by compass middle fine winds and latter fresh winds S. E. steering N W by N heavy weather caught 4 Porpoises Lat 48° 22' N Long 32° 05' W

840 Friday 9th Comm. with fresh Calcs at 3 P. M. took in sail rain and thick weather ship on the N tack middle moderate sound rain and fog latter light winds and heavy swell Black Tuck rain and fog in pleasant weather ship under easy sail Lat 48° 22' N

841 Saturday 10th Comm. with light wind N N a heavy swell ship on the S tack middle and latter light air and heavy swell from N W saw 2 steam ships Lat 47° 58' N Long 33° 21' W

842 Sunday 11th Comm. with light wind N N E steering N W a heavy swell from N W number of vessels and a heavy swell in sight light Calcs clear weather middle and latter light Calcs steering N W Lat 47° 58' N

843 Monday 12th Comm. with light Calcs N steering N W light Calcs cloudy over cast middle and latter fine wind from N N E fine breeze steering N W good weather some cloudy Lat 43° 41' N Long 35° 11' W

844 Tuesday 13th Comm. with fine breezes from N steering N W and N W by N N some cloudy middle and latter the same beautiful weather Lat 41° 03' N Long 36° 29' W

845 Wednesday 14th Comm. with light wind N and beautiful weather steering N W by N middle and latter the same at 11 A. M. P. saw a boat and board a Merchant Ship called Emily

Whiting of Boston from San Francisco bound to England loaded with Wheat 3 months and 10 days out Lat 39° 46' N Long 37° 35' W
