

Remarks On Board Bk. Ocean St. Bedford Co. N. Whaling Voyage
 Feb 8 March
 1050 Sunday 26th Calm. with fine wind from N at 11 A.M.
 Sailed for Spinnaker Whales and lowered two boats and as
 soon as the starboard boat came back from the merchant
 barge lowered 2 more boats so was 4 boats in chase of
 Spinnaker Whales with a good chance Lat 39° 01' S
 Long 47° 11' W
 1051 Monday 27th Calm. with fine weather four boats
 chasing 2 different Whales at 5 P.M. the Port boat
 of Flour struck at 6 P.M. took him along side middle good
 weather latter fair weather some swell from S.W.
 at 6 A.M. commence to cut so was a cutting Lat 39° 01' S
 1052 Tuesday 28th Calm. with fair weather fresh wind North
 at 6 P.M. finish cutting middle fresh Calm from North
 latter light gales N.W. at 8 A.M. commence to boil
 clear weather ship on Northward tack Lat 38° 46' S
 Long 46° 46' W
 1053 Wednesday 1st Calm. with light Calm N.W. ship on
 opposite tack boiling middle a heavy swell at 9 P.M. the
 the ship made a heavy roll and a roll the oil out of the Pot and
 segled a Portuguese by the name of Antonio cooled down latter
 heavy swell and calm employed in boiling Lat 38° 30'
 Long 46° 06' W
 1054 Thursday 2nd Calm. with calm heavy swell middle &
 latter light wind from N and N.W. steering the South
 and Northward see nothing Lat 38° 49' S
 Long 46° 36' W
 1055 Friday 3rd Calm. with fine breeze N.W. steering to the South
 & Northward under easy sail boiling middle at 3 A.M. four
 boats boiling latter fresh wind N and a rain ship on the Western
 tack under easy sail unpleasant Lat 39° 18' S

 1056 Saturday 4th Calm. with fresh Calm N.W. ship on opposite
 tack middle and latter light Calm N.W. all hands employed
 storing down oil in the Port Hatch way Lat 38° 40' S
 Long 47° 47' W
 1057 Sunday 5th Calm. with light Calm S.W. at 5 P.M. finish storing
 down oil middle and latter part fresh wind S.W. &
 a heavy swell from S ship on opposite tack Lat 38° 40' S
 Long 47° 16' W

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 1058 Monday 6th Calm. with strong winds & ship on opposite
 tack heavy swell middle calm and light air from N.W.
 latter strong breeze N.W. steering different courses Lat 38° 34' S
 Long 46° 20' W
 1059 Tuesday 7th Calm. with light Calm N.W. and some rain
 squalls ship steering different courses middle at
 10 P.M. the wind shifted to S.W. in a rain squall to the S.W.
 latter fresh wind N.W. ship on opposite tack Lat 38° 54' S
 Long 46° 00' W
 1060 Wednesday 8th Calm. with a light wind S and a heavy
 swell N.W. ship on the Eastern tack see nothing middle
 light wind N.W. and increasing steering N.W. by N latter
 light Calm N.W. steering N.W. by N see nothing Lat 39° 38' S
 Long 47° 10' W
 1061 Thursday 9th Calm. with light Calm N.W. ship on the N
 tack some squalls of rain middle some rain squalls light
 wind N.W. latter calm employed storing the between decks over
 and starting some coal at the P.M. Lat 39° 20' S

 1062 Friday 10th Calm. with light air from S & a calm
 middle light air N.W. latter fine breeze N.W. and good weather see
 nothing but employed ship on different tack Lat 38° 07' S
 Long 47° 26' W
 1063 Saturday 11th Calm. with fine breeze N.W. working Southward ship
 on opposite tack middle fresh wind from N.W. to N.W.
 ship on opposite tack latter light Calm & rain squalls Lat 38° 43' S
 Long 47° 32' W
 1064 Sunday 12th Calm. with light Calm from N.W. to N.W. and
 rain squalls middle and latter light Calm from S to E
 some rain steering N.W. by N see nothing Lat 38° 59' S
 Long 47° 09' W
 1065 Monday 13th Calm. with strong breeze from S.E. to S.E. steering
 N.W. by N and N.W. heavy swell middle and latter light
 wind from N.E. steering N.W. see nothing Lat 38° 44' S
 Long 50° 36' W
 1066 Tuesday 14th Calm. with light breeze from N.E. steering N.W. by N
 fine beautiful weather middle the same latter fresh wind
 from E.N.E. steering N.W. by N the watch employed in Repair
 ing the Old Fore top sail see nothing but Lat 37° 34' S
