

Remarks On Board Fk. Ocean N. Bedford On A. Whaling

March 1882

- 1067 Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> Com. with fresh wind from East at 5 P.M. fuick repairing top sail. Middle and Latter the same ship steering different courses. Lat 36° 58' S Long 53° 30' W
- 1068 Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> Com. with light winds to the N and E rain and mid rain steering N. N. W at 4 P.M. calms Middle and Latter fresh winds and Eales and some rain from the N to N. N. W ship on opposite tacks Lat 36° 47' S Long 53° 36' W
- 1069 Friday 20<sup>th</sup> Com. with light Eales N. N. W. ship on diff. ant. tacks Middle and Latter light gales from N. N. W and N. W working Netley saw 1 vessel bound S. Lat 36° 58' S Long 53° 39' W
- 1070 Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> Com. with fresh Eales N. N. W ship on opposite tacks Middle light Eales from N. N. W the ship on the Netley tacks Latter part calms a heavy swell Lat 36° 30' S Long 54° 43' W
- 1071 Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> Com. with calms and a heavy swell from N. N. W at 4 P.M. a light wind from N. N. W steering E & E and rain at sundown took in sail Middle Eales from N. N. W a Merchant frigate past bound S Latter Eales N. N. W working Netley ship on different tacks Lat 37° 20' S Long 54° 43' W
- 1072 Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> Com. with fresh Eales N. N. W ship on the North and Netley tacks making a N. N. W. Middle and Latter the same some rain squalls Lat 36° 53' S Long 53° 44' W
- 1073 Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> Com. with fresh Eales S. N. W ship on the North and Netley tacks a few rain squalls Middle moderate Latter light wind steering N. E by E a heavy swell from S. N. W saw a steam ship bound N Lat 36° 56' S Long 53° 18' W
- 1074 Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> Com. with light winds N. N. W a heavy light Eales well from S. N. W steering N. E Middle and Latter light rain Eales N. N. W and rain squalls steering N. E Lat 36° 33' S Long 51° 00' W
- 1075 Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> Com. with light Eales N. N. W some rain squalls Eales with steering N. E Middle and Latter the same very unpleasant some quite smart squalls of rain and rain the glass 29 and 4/10 the weather threatening no sun

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- 1076 Friday 24<sup>th</sup> Com. with fresh Eales S. E and fresh Eales with squalls of rain steering N. E by N unpleasant rain - Glass weather Middle and Latter part fresh squalls from 29 and 2/10 - S. E. to N. ship under close reef top sails the ship low saw the mer. saw 1 ship bound S No sun
- 1077 Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> Com. with fresh squalls from all points 4. bagged of the compass ship under close reef main top sail Glass of Eales low and very unpleasant weather the most of the time Eales saw Middle and Latter fresh Eales from S. to N. steering N. E a 1/2 k. bound saw a merchant bark bound S some squalls Lat 31° 31' S Long 46° 46' W
- 1078 Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> Com. with light Eales N. N. W steering N. E by E and some rain squalls Middle and Latter part fresh winds N. N. W steering N. E by E Lat 29° 56' S Long 44° 56' W
- 1079 Monday 27<sup>th</sup> Com. with fresh winds N. N. W steering N. E by E and nothing Middle and Latter light winds from N. N. W to N. N. W ship on the North and tacks saw Blackfish Lat 28° 00' S Long 44° 53' W
- 1080 Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> Com. with light winds from N. N. W to N. N. W saw a steamship on the North and tacks fine weather Middle calms Latter ship took light wind from S. and Eastward and rain see nothing off Coffee In Sun
- 1081 Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> Com. with light breezes from E to S & the shifted the ship on the North and Eastern tacks some rain squalls Middle and Latter light wind E and N. E ship on opposite tacks fine weather but see nothing Lat 26° 44' S Long 44° 39' W
- 1082 Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> Com. with light airs from the North and saw a steamship on the North and tacks some rain squalls Middle and Latter light wind from E to E & ship on opposite tacks Lat 27° 38' S Long 48° 39' W
- 1083 Friday 31<sup>st</sup> Com. with light winds E and fine pleasant weather ship on opposite tacks saw a number of Merchant vessels bound S Middle and Latter the same Lat 24° 56' S Long 43° 30' W
- 1084 Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> Com. with light winds E. N. E to E & fine weather Middle and Latter fresh winds from E to E ship on the same Eastern tacks Lat 28° 09' S Long 42° 00' W
