 4 Barrels by the First Mate got his Leggs & Arms in the after 11 by  
 4 Beef to east of Mast Middle and Latter light air from S. W.  
 4 bags to S. W. steering N. beautiful weather saw a. Brigg Lat 29° 44' N  
 Long 52° 44' W

1121 Monday 7<sup>th</sup> Calm. with light air from N. to W steering  
 clearing N. W. saw a. vessel Middle and Latter part light regular  
 ship to from S. W. to N. N. W. steering N. E. No Sun  
 Paint

1122 Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> Calm. with fine squalls winds from  
 S. W. to N. W. the ship on the North and Eastern tack  
 Middle and Latter light sails N. E. ship on opposite tacks  
 under easy sail the weather clear Lat 31° 08' N  
 Long 52° 00' W
