 1123 Wednesday 10th Com. with light Gale N E the ship on the North and Western tack Mialde and latter calms employed in cleaning ship Lat 31:32 Long 52:28
 1124 Thursday 11th Com. with light winds from N W the ship on the North and Eastern tack Mialde fresh winds from the N. W steering N and E No Sun
 1125 Friday 12th Com. with light Gale from N W and light Gale thick cloudy weather steering E cloudy Mialde and latter light winds and clouds Lat 33:30 N Long 50:06 W
 1126 Saturday 13th Com. with light winds N W and rain squalls Mialde and latter fresh winds N E and rain and fog the ship on different tacks Lat 34:07 N Long 50:10 W
 1127 Sunday 14th Com. with light winds E and cloudy weather ship on the Eastern and Northward tack Mialde and latter light winds N W steering N E Lat 35:31 N Long 49:21 W
 1128 Monday 15th Com. with light winds N W steering N E and N E Mialde and latter the same at 10 A M took in sail to paint ship inside Lat 36:09 N
 1129 Tuesday 16th Com. with fine winds N W good weather saw a vessel Mialde and latter the same saw a few passing vessels employed in painting Lat 36:11 N Long 50:11 W
 1130 Wednesday 17th Com. with fine winds and some cloudy at 2 P. M. finished painting ship in side Mialde and latter the same saw a few vessels bound E Lat 36:23 N Long 50:54 W
 1131 Thursday 18th Com. with fine winds at 5 P. M. moved ship to the east ward Mialde and latter the same Lat 36:43 N Long 50:11 W
 1132 Friday 19th Com. with light winds and the ship on the Eastern tack fine weather Mialde and latter light air and the last calms from South the ship on the Eastern tack saw 1 vessel to the South bound E Home sweet home Lat 36:42 N Long 50:00 W

 1133 Saturday 20th Com. with light air from South and saw a vessel calms the ship on the Eastern tack Mialde and latter light winds N W and calms steering E and saw a number of vessels Lat 36:36 N
 1134 Sunday 21th Com. with light air from S and Eastward saw hump. B. Mialde and latter the same saw hump backs Lat 36:35 N Long 49:10 W
 1095 Monday 22th Com. with light winds from N W to E the ship on the Eastern tack a few passing rain squalls Mialde and latter part fine breezes N W steering N E and E and cloudy Lat 36:04 N Long 46:39 W
 1096 Tuesday 23th Com. with strong winds from N W and rain steering E by S Mialde part winds N W and clear opened a latter the same saw a few fine backs steering E by S Lat 36:04 N Long 46:39 W
 1097 Wednesday 24th Com. with light winds N. W. steering E by S some clouds Mialde calms and rain latter fresh rain from E. N. E to N E some rain squalls Lat 36:00 N Long 45:06 W
 1098 Thursday 25th Com. with fresh winds E to E N E some squalls ship on the S. tack Mialde part the same latter light winds E. S. E at 8 A. M. spoke Bk. Gayhead of New Bedford 6 mo. out 50 lbs sperm Oil and gave her
 1099 Friday 26th Com. with light air from E. S. E and rain with the E. head at 9 P. M. finished the same Mialde light winds and latter fine breezes N W steering E S E Lat 36:10 N Long 43:40 W
 1100 Saturday 27th Com. with fine winds N W steering E S E the Bk. Gayhead in sight Mialde and latter strong breezes N. W. and N W steering E S E saw a few fine backs and hump Lat 36:15 N Long 40:06 W
 1101 Sunday 28th Com. with fresh winds N. S. W steering E S E at sundown took in sail and layed by for the night Mialde and latter weather the same at 6 A. M. made some sail steering E S E saw a few vessels and fine backs quite a heavy swell from N W Lat 36:08 N Long 38:14 W
 Home sweet home may kind Fortune smile on the Bk. Ocean and help her to get some Oil.
