 wave heavy swell at 9 P.M. broke up the Com for the
 night Middle the same Latter wind from N to NW some
 fog and finally a fresh Gale N.W. Lat 49:47 N
 Long 23:41 W

1140 Thursday 9th Com. with fresh Gale N.W. most part
 of the time clear ship on the Western tack under close
 reef main top sail and top stay sail and spencer
 Middle and Latter the same some squalls Lat 49:15 N
 Long 23:50 W

1141 Friday 10th Com. with fresh Gale N.W. a few rain
 and some squalls ship on the Western tack Middle
 and Latter the same some rain and some squalls
 North and East wave Lat 48:52 N
 Long 22:33 W

1142 Saturday 11th Com. with fresh Gale N.W. and
 Gale Pass the ship on the Eastern tack at 4 P.M. the steam
 a Steam Ship ship: vessel of Bremen bound to the Metropoli pass
 close to Middle and Latter the same some squalls
 Gale N.W. of rain and hail saw a few passing merchant vessels
 bound to and from passed Lat 49:15 N

 1 P.M. spoke the Com. Morris and had a game came on
 to blow from N and rain at 6 P.M. broke up the Com and
 took in sail Middle and Latter Gale from N to NW with
 some rain and squalls ship on opposite tacks Lat 50:03 N
 Long 23:12 W

1147 Thursday 13th Com. with fresh Gale from N and squalls
 unpleasant weather Middle and Latter fresh Gale N.W.
 and some squalls the ship on opposite tacks Lat 49:29 N
 Long 24:31 W

1148 Friday 14th Com. with Gale N.W. a few passing squalls
 ship on opposite tacks Middle the same Latter light
 air N and few passing squalls Lat 49:31 N
 Long 23:54 W

1149 Saturday 15th Com. with fresh Gale N.W. ship on the N
 and Eastern tack some squalls saw a number of
 steam ships and merchant vessels Middle and Latter
 fresh Gale from the N the ship on opposite tacks under
 close reef top sails and a few passing vessels Lat 49:39 N
 Long 23:12 W

1150 Sunday 16th Com. with light Gale N.W. some rain
 squalls the ship on opposite tacks saw a few passing
 vessels cloudy weather heavy swell from N.W.
 Middle light air & some rain and fog a heavy swell
 Latter fresh winds N and some fog Lat 49:32 N
 Long 23:00 W

1151 Monday 17th Com. with fresh winds N.W. and some
 fog & rain fog ship on opposite tacks Middle and Latter fresh
 Gale from N.W. the ship laying hove too on the Southern
 tack under close reef top sail main spencer some
 with squalls heavy squalls of rain and wind Lat 49:46 N
 Long 22:50 W
