

Remarks of the Weather up to Dec^r the 18. 1884 very mild about till 10th of December had the first snow storm of any amount the 19 day it came on with a light snow wind N. N. E. and S. N. W. and a very cold glass down to 6 degrees below zero the morning of the 20 and at sundown the glass 7 degrees above zero the morning of the 21 glass 32° above some snow but turned to rain and fog. 22. wind E. N. E. and E. to S. E. and S. E. to S. W. and N. to N. N. W. at 5 P. M. came on a smart tempest report says that it struck a dwelling house in Edgartown. 23 day quite a fair day Glass 22°. Wind S. W. and S. N. W. strong breeze a very low tide. Wednesday 24 fresh breeze N. E. to E. N. E. and snow at 1 P. M. some rain and hail Glass 30° and 34° the weather not interesting. Thursday 25. Wind S. W. and Glass on a coverage of 23. changeable weather the wind howling Easterly more snow coming. Friday 26 wind N. E. and a snow storm Glass 23 at noon stopped snowing wind fresh some hail the ground all covered with snow. Saturday 27. wind E. N. E. the weather more mild the sun out the most of the time a few snow squalls the afternoon cloudy wind in the eastern board. Sunday 28. wind E. to S. E. and light the coal barges started out for Boston Monday 29. light wind N. S. W. and S. W. some fog killed the Egg. Glass 44° 846° above. Tuesday 30 some fog in the morning wind S. W. Glass 42° to 58° above the most part of the day very pleasant Mr. Norton brought the Hogg. Name like Pork Spragda 440 lbs. Wednesday 31. fresh wind S. W. and fog Glass 44° to 56° Thursday 1. 1885 light wind and calm rain and fog Glass 50° to 54° Friday 2. strong winds from S. N. W. and S. W. clear and cold Glass 23 deg. to 12 above zero and growing cold two Pilots Births in Port Dim went to N. O. to carry a Capt. of a Barque Schooner that had his mauls broke. Saturday 3. calm and light wind S. W. Glass at sunrise 19° above zero. the rest of the day 30° above the air full of snow most all of the vessels gone East. Sunday 4. light wind S. W. some snow squalls Glass 33° at 9 A. M. with after noon S. E. wind and rain. Monday 5 fine weather S. W. wind Glass 44° 848°. Tuesday 6 wind S. E. and plenty rain Glass 52° to 56°.

Remarks on the Weather continued - 1885 -
Wednesday 7 - fresh wind S. W. to S. W. cloudy weather but Milott Glass 54° to 44° - a few hails started East. Thursday 8 - fine beautiful weather wind to South and West wind Glass 44° to 58° but a few hails. Friday 9 - still fine weather wind S. and Westward Glass 58° a few passing hails caught a Grass Hopper. Saturday 10 - wind S. W. and clear but cold Glass 35° above the wind blowing a gale see but a few hails passing. Sunday 11 - strong winds from S. W. and S. W. a raw cold wind Glass 44° to 40° below at sundown it looked like rain. Monday 12 wind S. E. and S. and plenty of rain some smart squalls of wind and rain Glass 44° to 56°. Tuesday 13. strong winds from S. W. to S. W. clear and cold Glass 31° to 30° at sundown wind moderated to light air. Wednesday 14. fresh wind S. had a late flurry of snow wind S. W. to S. W. and quite cold Glass 19° to 26° but a beautiful day. Thursday 15. fresh wind S. W. at 11 A. M. rain and snow and quite cold Glass 26° to 40 at dark wind light S. E. with rain unpleasant weather. Friday 16 wind S. S. W. S. E. and East S. E. with rain Glass 36° unpleasant weather quite warm weather. Saturday 17. fresh winds from S. W. with plenty of rain at 11 P. M. wind S. W. it cleared up some at sundown wind N. S. W. Glass 58° to 35 the wind blowing a Gale Mr. Moser came. Sunday 18 fresh winds from S. N. W. and clear and cold Glass 18° to 27° at sundown light wind S. W. fine weather. Monday 19. strong winds S. W. clear and cold Glass 18° 23° above. Tuesday 20. light wind S. N. W. clear and cold Glass 14° to 24° at 2 P. M. the wind E. N. E. and calm Capt. Horton caught a Hake to the Eastward. Wednesday 21. light wind to the S. and Westward a flurry of snow a fair day Glass 34° to 37° Lizzie took Maria. Thursday 22. calm from S. W. and very cold Glass 6° to 10° the side Board came. Friday 23. clear and cold wind S. W. Glass 7° to 10°. Saturday 24. moderated E. wind rain and snow Glass 32° 40° at 2 P. M. Mr. Moser came home sundown wind S. W. some fog. Sunday 25. light wind from South and Westward cloudy overcast a storm threatening quite cold 34° above.
