Sunday 21. in the morning wind blowing a Gale from NW
and cold Glass 14° above in the afternoon wind SW
and milder

Monday 22. wind from NW to SE and cold a light flurry of
snow some cloudy weather

Tuesday 23. wind SE to SW some rain the weather changed all
the Feb

Wednesday 24. fresh wind from NW and quite the Glass 20° to
Fair 24° the has been sick for a few days but is better now
Peter lost his Bargue by towing overboard gone to the Fair

Thursday 25. fresh wind from SE and cold Glass 20° at noon
came out to blow and snow at sundown Gales from SE
and rain storm Glass 38° above rain and snow through the day

Friday 26. in the morning heavy Gales from NW and snow storm at
times the Glass 24° to 11° above and still blowing heavy in gales

Saturday 27. Heavy Gales from NW and NW Glass 6° at sunrise
above at sundown sundown 13° above the Fetsels in the
Harbor all Ice up and two of them on shore on the east side
of the Harbor a heavy bank in the North and Eastern bays

Sunday 28. Moderate Gales NW and NW quite clear and cold Glass 12°
to 24° above two Fetsels on shore on the east side

Monday March 1. Gales from NW and NW and cold plenty of Ice
Glass 6° above at 9 P.M. Glass 3° above a few snow flakes

Tuesday 2. Gales NW Glass 6° above at sundown 18° above plenty of
Ice in the Harbor the steam boat came from New Bedford
the first time in 5 days

Wednesday 3. fresh wind NW and NW the Harbor full of Ice Glass
18° above and 28° above pleasant weather some steam came
near crowning in the Harbor

Thursday 4 Friday 5 Saturday 6. fine beautiful weather
a little cold wind NW and NW and NW some Ice still
in the Harbor Glass ranging from 20° above to 40°
above the most of the Fetsels gone Peter went Saturday
morning in tow of a Lug Boat

Sunday 7. fine beautiful weather wind NW Glass 20° to 36° above
some Ice in the Harbor

Remarks Aug 1. 1887

This day commences with unpleasant weather
rain and fog the wind went clear around the
compass it quite warm a few Fetsels in the Harbor
the Fetsels 14° above

Sunday 2. wind SE in the later part of the night it came
out to snow at daylight still snowing the ground
all covered with it blowing fresh at 8 A.M. clear
wind to SE and met with a few passing Fetsels it
growing cold at sundown Glass 14° above fresh
Gales at 10 P.M. Glass 11° above clear pleasant weather
but cold a few Fetsels moving Peter went to Port
to Boston Glass in the morning 6° above at 12 noon 13°

Monday 3. wind NW. Beautiful weather quite cold Glass 8°
Dredge above at 10 P.M. a few Fetsels in the Harbor this day was
fine with light northly wind pleasant weather

Tuesday 4. fine pleasant weather but cold Glass 10° above
at daylight wind North and this morning a heavy
white frost at 11 A.M. came in to snow and later
some 2 hours wind SE at sundown Glass 24° above
at 10 P.M. a cloudy over cast the wind SE and
light and milder weather

Wednesday 5. wind light from SE and mild weather
cloudy weather some snow of rain quite a number
of Fetsels a passing at 6 P.M. a few passing wind
gale the snow leaving fast the day hours clear
with a SE rain storm

Thursday 6. light wind SE and some snow working Northly
with weather at 10 A.M. stopped rain clouds
wind SE and NW and NW still quite milder
and later part wind light some rain and milder
some Glass from 24° to 31° above pleasant weather

Friday 7. calm with light wind North and met more
pleasant winter weather at 10 A.M. Glass 24° above
middle the same at 10 P.M. Glass 31° the wind increasing
from NW a few passing Fetsels middle fresh wind from
SE to SE and then a light flurry of snow Glass at
sunrise 14° above
