

Remarks on the weather Jan. 1884

Saturday 8th Commenced with fresh breeze from E and a quite
calm at 7 A.M. Glass 14th at about a few fathoms of surface
a few fathoms mooring at noon Glass 24th above pleasant
weather for weather. Latter part at 8 P.M. Glass 14th

Sunday 9th - Commenced with E. N.E. at 8 A.M. Glass 14th above
cloudy threatening snow. Middle of rain & a cold
strong wind at noon commenced to snow at sundown
weather looking bad Glass 15th above Latter some
rain and a few small winds & E

Monday 10th Calm with gale from E and at daylight wind S.W.
and light mild weather a few fathoms mooring
some snow flakes Middle fresh wind to the N.W.
and most warm at dark quite cold Glass 20th Latter
the same more pleasant & fresh

Tuesday 11th Calm with fresh breeze from the North and West
part quite cold Glass 20th at daylight and
the fog clear Middle the same a few fathoms mooring
some mild breeze from N.W. to S.W. at a moderate

Wednesday 12th Calm with light air and calm and mild
foggy weather Middle wind N.W. to S.W. quite a strong breeze
a few fathoms mooring Capt. Norton & crew caught
10 days of E. in light sand Latter part the same

Thursday 13th Calm with mild weather wind S.W. Capt. Norton
got a cargo for Boston Middle the same at sundown
calm at 10 P.M. light wind E and cloudy Latter
strong wind N.E. a snow storm a commotion

Friday 14th Calm wind N.E. and blowing a Gale and a snow
storm very unpleasant Capt. Norton came back for
a cargo Middle fresh breeze from E. to E. S. and
rain and fog the snow most all gone at sundown
wind N.W. and close weather Latter part
light wind from N.W. to E. N.W. Glass 28th above

Saturday 15th Calm light wind North and calm a heavy frost
Glass 26th at a average about 26th above Middle wind
E and S.E. with snow very unpleasant weather
Latter part clear milder North and milder
quite cold Glass 20th above

Sunday 16th Calm fine weather wind North and West wind light Glass
18th above Middle beautiful weather a few fathoms
mooring at sundown calm Glass 24th above Latter
calm weather more mild

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Monday 17th Calm with light wind East and a moderate quite
mild Middle fresh wind E and S.E. at 6 P.M. the same
snow Middle S.W. plenty of rain Latter part the same

Tuesday 18th Calm with light wind N.W. and snow Glass 20th above at
daylight wind N.W. and clear and cold at sundown Glass
20th at 9 P.M. Glass 6th above light breeze N.W. quite a
number of fathoms mooring Latter part fresh breeze
N.W. and very cold Glass 20th

Wednesday 19th Calm with light breeze S.W. Glass at 10 at daylight the
Capt. Norton Middle the same to the West all of the Eastern Middle
for Boston started for Boston Middle Glass 24th above wind S.W.
at 10 P.M. wind N.W. Glass 28th above Latter calm

Thursday 20th Calm with calm and mild weather at 10 P.M.
light wind from S.E. and a close weather
Middle light wind S.E. and a mild weather Latter
S.W. wind and a fine weather quite warm Glass 24th

Friday 21th Calm with light wind S.W. and fine warm weather
Capt. Norton Middle the same quite a number of fathoms
mooring at sundown wind N.W. and fine Latter
mild from S.W. and a mild weather

Saturday 22th Calm with calm and mild weather Middle
fresh wind S.W. and warm and pleasant at
daylight Middle cloudy weather Latter S.W. wind and pleasant

Sunday 23th Calm with gale from S.W. and warm Middle the same
Latter fresh breeze from S.W. and a very mild and mild
rain and unpleasant weather

Monday 24th Calm with fresh breeze from S.W. and a mild weather
Middle the same but plenty
of rain at 9 P.M. wind S.W. Latter wind the same

Tuesday 25th Calm with strong winds S.W. and N.W. Glass 28th above
fine winter weather Middle wind N.W. and S.W. a
number of fathoms mooring at sundown mild
weather but blowing a Gale S.W. Latter the same

Wednesday 26th Calm with S.W. breeze and warm weather and pleasant
rain Middle cloudy weather wind moderated at sundown
wind N.W. rain and snow but mild weather Latter
light breeze S.W. and a clear Glass 6th above a
few fathoms mooring were 3 master Sch. in square harbor
Shoal steam tug of Chatham put off Thursday took the 2nd day
