Monday June 21st
All this day 24 hours fresh breezes from the N^W and fair weather Steered to the South & East Saw a Brig steering N^W under a heavy press of sail

Tuesday June 22nd
Begins with fine breezes from the N^W and fair weather Steered East one sail in sight Steering N^W under a heavy press of sail latter part fresh breezes from the South and fine weather

Lat obs 31 00 Long 58 30

Wednesday June 23rd
Begins with strong breezes from the South Steered E by S under a heavy press of sail latter part squally

Lat obs 30 24 Long 58 33

Thursday June 24th
Begins with fine breezes from S^W and squally appearance Steered S^W under all sail middle part light winds from the N^W at 8 PM spoke the Brig Martin Northampton of Providence from Boston for Cape Cod and put some letters on board to go home

Lat obs 29 45 Long 58 10

Friday June 25th
all this day light air from the South West and calm breeze to the South & East under the top gallant sails to repair Saw a lunge Shark and some flying Squirrels

Lat obs 28 58 Long 59 59

Saturday June 26th
all this day light winds from the East of S Steered East at 4 PM heave the top of Sails and set the fore and main sails following N^W great quantity of gull weed in sight

Lat obs 31 5 Long 59 00

Sunday June 27th
all this day light winds from the South and fine weather Steered N^E Saw great quantity of gull weed

Lat obs 31 12 Long 58 47

Monday June 28th
all this day light winds from the N^W and fine weather in sail in sight to the N^W

Lat obs 31 58 Long 58 00

Tuesday June 29th
Begins with light winds from the N^W and squally clouds Steered N^E at 10 PM spoke with Rain latter part fine breezes from the N^W and pleasant Steered N^E Left obs

Lat obs 33 12 Long 55 15

Wednesday June 30th
all this day fine breezes from the N^W and pleasant weather Steered East at 10 PM one sail in sight Steering to the East

Lat obs 33 12 Long 53 15

Thursday July 1st
Begins with fine breezes from the West and squally clouds Steered E at middle and latter part much the same Steered S^W to the N^W Saw porpoises

Lat obs 33 58 Long 52 19

Friday July 2nd
Begins with fine breezes from the West and squally clouds Steered N^E at sunset took in the light sails middle and latter part much the same one sail in sight to the N^W Steering East

Lat obs 34 26 Long 49 45

Saturday July 3rd
Begins with fine breezes from N^W and squally clouds Steered East at 4 PM picked up a sheet iron buoy covered with clams at sunset took in the light sails middle part squally with Rain Double kept the top sails at daylight made all sail at 10 AM the wind shifted to the N^E one sail in sight of our lee beam Steered on the wind to the South & East exposed to be a Solomon
