

Brig Ocean of Sandwich

Wednesday July 29th
 Begins with light airs and Calms at 3 PM
 Saw Blackish towards the point got nothing
 at took in sail at day light Calm
 Hoisted down the Eel at 10 saw Black
 Ship lowered two boats but found
 them to be from one boat in
 sight to the West

Thursday July 30th
 First part Calm at 7 PM light air from the
 W headed along the land to the East saw
 grampses and perkins one sail in sight
 to the Westward at 1 PM took in sail and
 part strong breezes with rain falling heavy
 from the North West made sail off the
 Ship Thomas of New Bedford several
 sails in sight to the Westward

Friday July 31st
 Begins with strong gale from the North
 and squally middle much the same later
 part strong breezes and passing clouds steering
 along the land to the West the Thomas L. in
 sight to the North

Saturday Aug 1st
 Begins with moderate gale from the N E
 and squalls of fine rain at 9 PM took in
 sail the W part of the Michael Bone to
 distant miles middle part fine rather heavy
 white clouds the Brig at 1 PM made
 sail and stood in for the Bay several
 sails in sight to the N E and fine weather
 strong breezes from the N E and fine weather
 squally nothing of the wind one chosen
 steering in for the Bay

Sunday Aug 2nd
 All these 24 hours fine breezes from the N E
 and fine weather saw Grampses steering E
 at day light got the light early the East
 end of the Michael Bone at 10 leagues
 at 3 PM steered S W and went the light to the
 repairs at 10 minutes the East end of the Michael
 Bone N E South saw Grampses

Tuesday Aug 3rd
 Begins with fine breezes from the North and Calm
 with fine rain steered S W at 1 PM made
 the Maria Bearing S W at 5 saw the ants at
 7 PM took in sail heading to the North E
 at 9 PM light wind from the North inclining
 to the West ship to the North E East middle
 part light winds and passing a quantity of fine rain
 at day light were off to the South West and
 made all sail the Maria in sight Bearing S W
 the Michael S W at 10 in midian the ants Bone
 W of the Maria at 11

Wednesday Aug 4th
 Begins with strong breezes from the N E
 and passing clouds at 7 PM strong breezes took
 in the light sails of Maria Bone West 2 leagues
 at 7 PM took in the sails and double reef
 the top sails the Maria Bone dist 2 leagues
 middle part strong breezes from the North
 headed N W at day light turned out the reefs
 steered W N E for the Bay steering E N E
 at 10 took in sail and steered S E till 10 30
 Long 26 14

Thursday Aug 5th
 Begins with strong breezes from the North
 and passing clouds one sail in sight steering
 E N E at 1 PM more moderate steered
 S E at 7 backed to the wind and took in
 middle part squally at 5 PM set the fore
 sail and fish and turned out the reefs
 ends with strong breezes from the North and
 squally steered S E several sails in sight
 steering East
 Lat obs 35 12 Long 27 42

Friday Aug 6th
 Begins with strong breezes from the North
 and squally steered S E saw a grampse
 looking at 7 PM took in sail middle part
 light breezes from the North and squally with
 fine rain headed to the North E East at day
 light made all sail steered S E and with
 moderate gale from the North E East with
 fine rain
 Lat by IR 35 35
 Long 27 46
