

Brig Ocean off St. Mary

Tuesday Sept 14th

Begins with light air from the NW & fair
calm, employed setting up the head stays
middle part wind inclining fresh latter
part strong breezes from NW & fair
squally

Wednesday Sept 15th

Begins with fine breezes from the NW with
hazy weather shifted on the wind to the South
& East at 4 PM heavy squalls took in sails
to a close reefed main top sail middle
part strong breezes and squally set the
Boats on the upper chains latter part increasing
gale with a high cross sea running at noon
Kept the by sail and abut

Thursday Sept 16th

Begins with heavy gales from the SW
and cloudy reaching to the South & East
middle close reefed main top sail at 4 PM
sails and by sail at 4 PM a high sea
bearing from the NW the Brig shrouding
very hard wore ship to the North & W middle
part heavy gales from the SW with squalls
of rain at 4 PM increasing gale and heavy
squalls pulled up the weather clear of the main
top sail at 6 PM broke away clear in the
West and more moderate sail close reefed
top sails Lat 35-04 Long 42-33

Friday Sept 17th

Begins with heavy gales from the SW and
hazy weather reached to NW at 3 PM
increasing gales took in the fore top sail
at 6 wore ship to the South middle part strong
gale and heavy squalls pulled up the weather
clear of the main top sail at 6 PM wind
inclining westerly wore ship to the NW ends
with heavy gales and a high cross sea
set down the main Royal & fore top
gallant yards and took in the West Boat

Saturday Sept 18th

Begins with strong gales from the South & West
reached to NW at 6 PM wind inclining Westly
wore ship to the South at 8 PM the wind shifted
to the North & East middle part more moderate
wind inclining Westly at day light moderate
with a heavy adust heavily from the NW made
at sail and shifted to NW a Barquentin light
steering the same course Lat 34-42 Long 22-12

Sunday Sept 19th

Begins with light wind from the NW and a heavy
fog bearing from the West & sails in light
leading to the Southward at 7 double reefed
the top sails took in the main sail & jib. Stead
at 8 PM middle part moderate gales from the East
and cloudy latter part strong breezes and squally
steered to several sails in sight steering
to the South West

Monday Sept 20th

Begins with strong breezes from the East Steered
to with Rain & fair several sails steering
at 6 PM strong gale from the East and
squally took in the fore sail and close reefed
the top sails middle part strong gale from
the East and squally with Rain-Kept the
at day light set the fore sail at 8 PM
Long 21-52

Tuesday Sept 21st

Begins with heavy gales from the ENE and squally
reached to at 1 PM took in the fore sail
at 6 increasing gale and heavy squally took
in the fore top sail and reefed the by sail
middle part heavy gale from the East and
Rain latter part heavy gale with Rain
& squally sea bearing from the East
took in the West Boat

Wednesday Sept 22nd

Begins with strong breezes from the East and
Rain clouds at the fore top sail close reefed
middle part strong breezes and heavy squally
took in the fore top sail at day light more moderate
at 8 PM kept top sail at 8 wore ship to the South
Ends more moderate and squally Lat 33-10
Long 22-10
