the South made several tracks to the
South at 2⁰⁰ PM. finished heading at day
light made at sail heading in for the
land four days in sight. One with light
breeze from the South and fine weather
when I headed of shore.

to the South & West employed Stowmen
along the ship. End with light air from

Begins with strong breezes from the N. & increasing westerly. Clear & fresh. The ship sails for the main sail and jib all day but at 4:00 pm heavy gale from the West looking thick and squally in the West. Hope for a clear under venture with the loss of Lobs in sight.

 Begins with strong breezes from the West
 and thick weather. Pass under the lee of
 Pentung Eber and sail of Merchant vessels
 in sight & three anchors at 4 PM Make
 the America make good moderate gale
 from the West and fair weather. Some
 lightning on the 14 & today high light
 clouds from the West with thick clouds
 wither made a N. by E. wind along
 shore to the South & West in ca. with
 the America. Ends with light air and
 Calms

Thursday Nov 18th
at this day light and from the North
and East got some provisions from
the canoe two wabags in sight
the Phenix & W. Arrive

Sunday Nov 19 11

Friday Nov 19th
Begin with light airs from the North
and Calm. Three whalers in sight put
some letters on Board the Western. Hearing
of Providence to go home yet. Sprang
hook in tail of the mouth of the Star
and Capt. with the company made fair
light airs from the North and the boat
rather fresh light baffling wind and
fine with considerable several flocks to
the North. Put on old blouse
