

Brig Ocean of Sandwich

Sunday Nov 28th

Begins with strong breezes from the N. and fine weather. Sailed to the South. Got along shore under close Reefed top Sails at 5 P.M. Commenced boiling water on the wind to the S. by 7 miles per hour. Strong breezes and cloudy. Later part squally.

Monday Nov 29th

Begins with strong breezes from the N. and squally with a heavy sea. Employed boiling water for the boiler, much the same later part being gale and squally. Moved for the South end of Puerto Venturo.

Tuesday Nov 30th

All this day strong gales from the North with heavy squalls. Employed boiling at 2 P.M. Run under the lee of S. Ventura. Light breeze and squally. Employed repairing the vessel.

Wednesday Dec 1st

Begins with strong breezes from the North and heavy squalls with rain. Sailed under close Reefed top Sails. Employed down the gale at 5 P.M. Sailed the North Point and commenced making port more snug and clear. Sailed to the N. and under close sail at day light. Strong breezes from the N. and squally. Employed the top sail and heavy squalls. Later part squally.

Thursday Dec 2nd

All this day strong breezes from the North and squally with rain. Employed the top sail and under the lee of the wind under close Reefed top Sails. Sailed to the North end for the land.

Cruising off Bocayear Straits Dec 12

Friday Dec 3rd

Begins with strong winds from the N. and headed in for the land under close Reefed top Sails. In P.M. with the America middle part moderate faster part strong breezes and cloudy with a heavy squall from the N. and headed to the N. under close Reefed top Sails. The America in sight but two porpoises.



Saturday Dec 4th

Begins with strong breezes from the East and squally. Employed repairing the top sail at 8 o'clock. Headed off shore middle part more moderate at 2 P.M. were ship to the North at day light made all sail. Sailing off N. and squally. Employed repairing the top sail.

Sunday Dec 5th

All this day light air and calm at 1 P.M. finished and bent the top sail.

Monday Dec 6th

First part calm middle part light wind from the East. Later part fine breezes from the East and N. part weather headed to the North & East. Strong breeze of Lancaster.

Tuesday Dec 7th

Begins with moderate gales from the N. and squally. Headed in for the land at 2 P.M. Sailed West for the N. part middle part fine weather. Headed off shore at day light. Fine breezes from the N. and clear at night. Headed in for the Straits at 10 o'clock. Sailed Spanish Run in sight. Sailing in from the Straits. Land towards the N. and South of Porpoises.
