

Brig Ocean of Sandwich

Wednesday Dec 8th

Begins with strong breezes from the South inclining perfectly S.W. up to the S.E. West of Lancashire the water employed setting up the top mast rigging at 5 PM took in the light sails. Calms and close reefed the top sail one. Rhogues in sight to the S.W. middle part variable winds and squally at day light strong breezes from the North and West and squally with thunder rather hot more moderate variable one. Set in light to the N.W. to lower light bearing. S.E. dist 4 leagues

Thursday Dec 9th

Begins with moderate breezes from the N.E. and fine weather. A heavy swell beginning from the N.W. at 2 PM the wind shifted to the N.W. and the ship and the vessel for the Strait much fast light air from the N.W. inclining Easterly at day light light wind from West to the S.W. at 10 miles latter part light air from the N.W. & fine weather. Friday Dec 10th Dec 10

Begins with light air and calms reached in light breeze to the water employed setting up the mast rigging at sundown. Shortened sails at 8 PM. Took back the main top sail. Close in with Lancashire wind N.W. middle part light breeze from the N.W. inclining Westerly at day light made all sail and turned off short winds. N.W. at 10 miles saw squally squally to the windward lowered the boats pulled up. Found them to be killers one sail in sight to the N.W.

Saturday Dec 11th

Begins with fine breeze from the N.W. and S.W. to the North & East. Strong shore of Lancashire under all sail at 10 miles light air from the N.W. took in the flying jib & jib top. S.W. at day light strong breeze from the N.W. & S.W. saw Black fish. Lowered the boats got nothing at a distance. Bore N.W. dist 5 leagues

Cruising off Lancashire Dec 9th

Sunday Dec 11th

Begins with strong breeze from the N.W. and S.W. under double reefed the top sail. Took in the main sail and took in top sail & jib. A Breeze in sight to the windward under of light sail at 5 PM took in the fore sail and close reefed the top sail. Middle part heavy gale from the S.W. high N.W. at 10 miles thick and began with a heavy swell beginning from the West one sail in sight to the N.W. and

Monday Dec 12th

Begins with light winds from the N.W. and S.W. headed N.W. & S.W. Breeze in sight to the windward middle part strong breezes from the West and squally with thunder and lightning at day light more moderate with a heavy squally breeze from the West. Breeze out the keels and the engines at Breeze in light under short sail. Ends with strong breezes from the West and squally breeze N.W. under in sight of our lee

Tuesday Dec 13th

Begins with strong breeze from the West and squally. Shortened for the North. Ends of night at 5 PM. Run in between of a great and a Clouie and Maria along shore to the S.W. which N.W. at sundown took in sail. Close reefed the top sail and lowered the engines top sail and with middle part strong breezes from the N.W. inclining Easterly at day light moderate gale from the North made all sail and turned to the N.W. Ends with strong breezes from the North and thick running to the N.W. along shore

Wednesday Dec 14th

Begins with strong breeze from the North and S.W. Clouie at 7 PM. Jackyard faint Bore N.W. dist 3 leagues at sunset close reefed the top sail middle part moderate at day light jackyard faint Bore N.W. & S.W. sail & turned. S.W. at day light squally altered West
