Wednesday Jan 12th
 Begins with fresh breeze from the East
 and fair weather headed by the North &
 East gale, Lancaster letter sent light
 wind from the South and fine weather

Thursday Jan 13th
 Begins with light wind from the SE and clear
 headed N by 3 PM spoke the Barque Cecilia
 of New Bedford. A Breeze from the South
 past light wind from the East and fine weather
 headed E by N in Company with the Barque Ocean
 Ends with light air from the SE and clear

Friday Jan 14th
 Begins with light air from the SE and fine
 weather discharged 2 men to go on board the Cecilia
 at 3 PM packed Company with the Barque and
 turned Westward and better party from within
 all hands employed at work in the rigging
 left the fore top mast standing sail on the
 harbour side from 10 AM to 12 noon in sight

Saturday Jan 15th
 All this day light wind from E by S to
 E by N all hands employed at work on the R/R
 and painting Palma in sight 10 miles

Sunday Jan 16th
 All this day light wind from the E and
 fine weather Steered West

Monday Jan 17th
 Begins with fair breeze from the East
 and fine weather middle part strong breeze
 left much the same employed at work on the
 Rigging and Painting Latob 28 50 Long 21 00

Tuesday Jan 18th
 All this day fair breeze and passing clouds
 Steered W by N by Compass all hands employed
 fitting Rigging and Painting Latob 28 45
 Long 23 00

 Begins with fair breeze and passing clouds
 employed fitting Rigging and Painting
 Steered W by N by Compass Latob 28 45
 Long 26 00

Thursday Jan 20th
 All this day moderate gale squally in
 squalls from E by N to E by S the N by E
 gale sent it down saw fin back
 Latob 28 45 Long 28 35

Friday Jan 21th
 Begins with variable wind and squally
 sent a new main top sail & main top
 gallant sail repaired the old main top
 gallant sail and sent it up foreward
 at 8 PM Steered Westward E by S mile
 and later part squally Latob 28 00 Long 31 31

Saturday Jan 22nd
 All this day variable wind and squally
 Steered Westward from E by N to East
 Latob 28 25 Long 33 08

Sunday Jan 23rd
 All this day fair breeze from East to South
 and cloudy Steered West by Compass
 Latob 28 45 Long 34 00

Monday Jan 24th
 Begins with fair breeze from SE and
 fine weather saw a Brig Steering E by S mile
 past wind East & cloudy at 8 PM saw
 a ship Steering to the North & East
 Latob 28 32 Long 35 00

Tuesday Jan 25th
 All this day strong breeze from East
 and passing clouds Steered E by N
 saw great quantities of gulf weed
 and flying fish repaired the jibs
 and E by N made stay sail
 Latob 28 25
 Long 41 15
