Wednesday May 25th

Begins with fine breezes from the South West Steered N W at sunset Close Reep'd the top sails and furled the Courses mid Middle part Strong breezes with Squally appearance with lightning headed to the N at day light more moderate made sail sent up the main Royal yard at 11 AM tacked to the N W Several large ships in sight bound Eastward the week employed setting up rigging Lat Obs 34 34 Long 73 05

Thursday May 26th

Begins with strong breezes from the South and N headed N W at sunset Close Reep'd the top sails and wore ship to the South East middle part the wind backed to the N W and squally with thunder & lightning saw several sails through the night at day light strong breezes from N W and passing clouds with a heavy sea saw several large ships steering East

Friday May 27th

Begins with strong breezes from the West and fine weather middle part more moderate at day light made sail and steered S W saw several large ships bound Eastward Lat Obs 33 48 Long 73 50

Saturday May 28th

Begins with fine breezes from the West and pleasant Steered S W several sails in sight middle and latter part light airs from the N W Lat Obs 33 00 Long 73 18

Sunday May 29th

Begins with light winds from the South West and fine weather at sunset Strong Breezes from the South with rain Close Reep'd the top sails and furled the Courses mid part fine breezes from the N W at 3 PM heavy squalls from the N W with thunder and lightning at sunrise fine breezes from E and passing clouds at 9 AM Steered S W under Close Reep'd main top sail and with fine breezes from N E and passing clouds Lat Obs 32 47 Long 73 18

Cruising on the Charleston Ground

Monday May 30th

Begins with strong breezes from N E and fine weather Steered S W at sunset Close Reep'd the top sails middle part fine weather headed S E at day light made all sail and steered N W several sails in sight Lat Obs 31 44 Long 74 18

Tuesday May 31st

Begins with light winds from the N E East and fine weather Steered West several sails in sight bound Eastward at sunset Shortened sail middle part light winds from the North and fine weather latter part calm employed setting up the head rigging Lat Obs 31 58 Long 75 22

Wednesday June 1st

Commences with light airs from the N E headed West saw some grampases at sunset Shortened sail and headed South middle part fine weather at day light made all sail Steered S W by winds the one sail in sight to the East Lat Obs 31 14 Long 75 25

Thursday June 2nd

Begins with moderate gale from the N E Steered N W few sails in sight Steered N W at sunset Close Reep'd the main top sail and wore to heading to the South middle part fine weather at day light fine breezes from the E made sail and steered N W at 9 AM Steered South one sail in sight to the Eastward Ends with fine breezes from E and fine weather Steered South Lat Obs 31 25 Long 75 49

Friday June 3rd

Begins with fine breezes from E and pleasant Steered South 2 sails in sight Steering West at sunset Reep'd the top sails and Steered S W middle part fine breezes from the East and passing clouds headed S E at day light Strong breezes from E made all sail and steered South at 2 PM spoke the Calicut and 2 other Providence saw two more sails to the S W Ends with fine breezes and pleasant weather two sails in sight to the N W Lat Obs 29 20 Long 75 50
