

Wednesday May 24th
First part Calm. Middle part light airs
from the East and Cloudy. Latter light airs from
the W and same Cloudy. Saw Blackfish
lowered the Boat got mending 5 sails in sight
Lat 34 30 Long

Thursday May 25th
Begins with fine breezes from the N E and
Cloudy. Steered E S employed mending sails
middle and latter part mended the same seven
sails in sight Steered East Lat 34 16 Long 54 30

Friday May 26th
All this day fine breezes from the North and
Slight Steered East employed Repairing and
mending old sails one Barque in sight Steering
to the W W beyond her to be a whale
Lat 34 09 Long 56 30

Saturday May 27th
Begins with moderate gales from the North and
fine weather. Steered E W under all sails middle
part fine breezes from the west Steered E N
latter part strong breezes from the S W and
fine weather passed a barque Steering E S
Saw a great nr. of flying fish Lat 34 5

Sunday May 28th
Begins with strong breezes from the S W and
fine weather Steered East under South Keel
top sails middle part water much the same
latter part strong gales from the South and
thick weather

Monday May 29th
All this day heavy gales from the South
with thunder and lightning and heavy rain
the fire raging too under Close Keel main
top sail

Tuesday May 30th
Begins with heavy gales from the South
with thunder and lightning headed E S
under Close Keel main top sail night
part the wind halled to the West and Clear
off at day light made all sails Steered East

Wednesday May 31st
Begins with fine breezes from the West
and T. fine Clouds Steered E S Saw Porpoise
middle part light winds from the North Steered
E S at 5 AM the wind halled to the S W
End with strong breezes and fine weather
Lat 35 26 Long 57 40

Thursday June 1st
Begins with light wind and fine weather
Steered E S middle and latter part weather
much the same Ticked up a piece of a
Ship's top mast about 5 feet long Lat 35 10 Long 57 45

Friday June 2nd
Begins with light winds from S W and
fine weather Steered E S middle and latter part
fine breezes from the South Steered E S by Com
Lat 35 06 Long 58 30

Saturday June 3rd
Begins with fine breezes from W S W Steered
S E at 7 PM double Reefed the top sails
middle part water much the same at day
light made all sails Steered South wind
W S W 2 sails in sight Steering East
Saw Blackfin finbacks and Porpoise Lat 34 20
Long 59 40

Monday June 4th
All this day strong gales from the West inclining
southerly headed to the S W under Close Keel
top sails Saw a large Ship Steering S E
Lat 33 20 Long 59 10

Tuesday June 5th
All this day strong breezes from E S and
fine weather Steered S E under all sails
Lat 32 54

Wednesday June 6th
All this day light winds from the East
and fine weather Sailed at large Breeze
about sunset repaired off at day light
Saw a Barque to the Windward heading
to the North & East Lat 32 33
