

Saturday July 22nd
Begin with light winds from the W & at 9 AM
tacked to the East
Lat 33 15 Long 75 15

Sunday July 23rd
Begin with strong trade winds and rising clouds
light S.W. at 7 AM. Close reefed the top
sails, saw several whales. At 10 AM. began
on a light breeze and fine weather
at day light run under the lee of the land
saw several sails running along shore

Monday July 24th
All this day light air and Calms. Close in
with the land the watch employed Tacking

Tuesday July 25th
All this day light winds from the South and
fine weather. Headed to the South & West
land in sight

Wednesday July 26th
All this day light baffling winds and Calms.
Saw many porpoises. At 10 AM. took down the top
sail and repaired it. Lat 31 44 Long 75 20

Thursday July 27th
All this day fine breeze from the W & and
Clear Skies. At 8 PM. heavy dew at night
Lat 31 20 Long 75 14

Friday July 28th
All this day fine trade winds and pleasant Steer
at night heavy dew. Run under short
sail. Lat 31 00 Long 75 30

Saturday July 29th
All this day strong gales from the W & and at
night heavy dew. Close reefed the top sails
and worked to the W

Sunday July 30th
All this day strong gales from the W & and
cloudy Steer to the South and W. under
Close Reefes. Lat 30 53 Long

Monday July 31st
Begin with strong trade winds and cloudy Steer
at sunset saw porpoises. At 10 AM. at day
light made sail Steer south at 1 PM. Steer
W & W saw porpoises one north Lat 29 21

Tuesday Aug 1st
Begin with moderate gales from the W & and Cloudy
Steer at 2 PM. Saw porpoises. Began to
middle and latter part fine weather Steer
to the South & West along shore

Wednesday Aug 2nd
All this day fine breeze from the W & good
steer worked to the South along shore
off and on

Thursday Aug 3rd
All this day fine breeze and rising Clouds
Steer to the West for the Canary at 11 PM.
tacked Close in to the land saw several
ships to anchor and one on shore

Friday
Begin with fine trade winds Steer East at
9 PM. Saw Breachings of the whales. Row 3 PM.
off but could not tell if they were same
saw nothing more much part of night. At the
Port much the same Steer in between
Canary and Tenerife

Saturday Aug 4th
All this day strong trade winds Steer in for Canary
at 5 PM. Saw whales towards the boat.
Struck and chased at sunset. Close reefed
the top sails middle and latter part strong
gale and at heavy sea. Run under the lee of Canary

Sunday Aug 5th
Begin with strong gales from the E. Laying to
under the lee of Canary

Monday Aug 6th
All this day heavy gales from the E & and
Clear laying to under lee of the Grand
Canary
